
## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 2 PERCENT FROM A YEAR EARLIER

Cattle and calves on feed February 1, 1984, for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.92 million head, down 2 percent from a year ago but 12 percent above February 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during January totaled 1.57 million, down 4 percent from 1983 but 3 percent above 1982.

<u>PLACEMENTS</u> of cattle and calves on feed during January were 1.57 million, 5 percent more than last year and 7 percent greater than January 1982. <u>NET PLACEMENTS</u> of 1.48 million are 9 percent more than last year and 8 percent above January 1982.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 86 thousand head compared with 130 thousand during January 1983 and 81 thousand two years ago.
