

DAIRY PRODUCTS

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NOVEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 94.2 million pounds (42.7 thousand metric tons) in November, 11 percent more than November 1980 but 6 percent less than October 1981.

American type cheese totaled 191 million pounds (86.8 thousand metric tons), 8 percent above November 1980 but 4 percent below a month earlier this year.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 326 million pounds (148 thousand metric tons), up 3 percent from the previous year but was 4 percent below October 1981.

Creamed cottage cheese, 58.8 million pounds (26.7 thousand metric tons), down 1 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 14.8 million pounds (6710 metric tons), 15 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 60.3 million pounds (27.4 thousand metric tons), up 20 percent from November 1980.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with November 1980)

Ice cream -- 57.5 million gallons (218 million liters), up 8 percent.

Ice milk -- 18.2 million gallons (69.0 million liters), up 9 percent.

Sherbert -- 2.58 million gallons (9.77 million liters), up 12 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with November 1980).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 88.2 million pounds (40.0 thousand metric tons), up 28 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 8.60 million pounds (3900 metric tons), up 16 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.17 million pounds (1440 metric tons), up 4 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

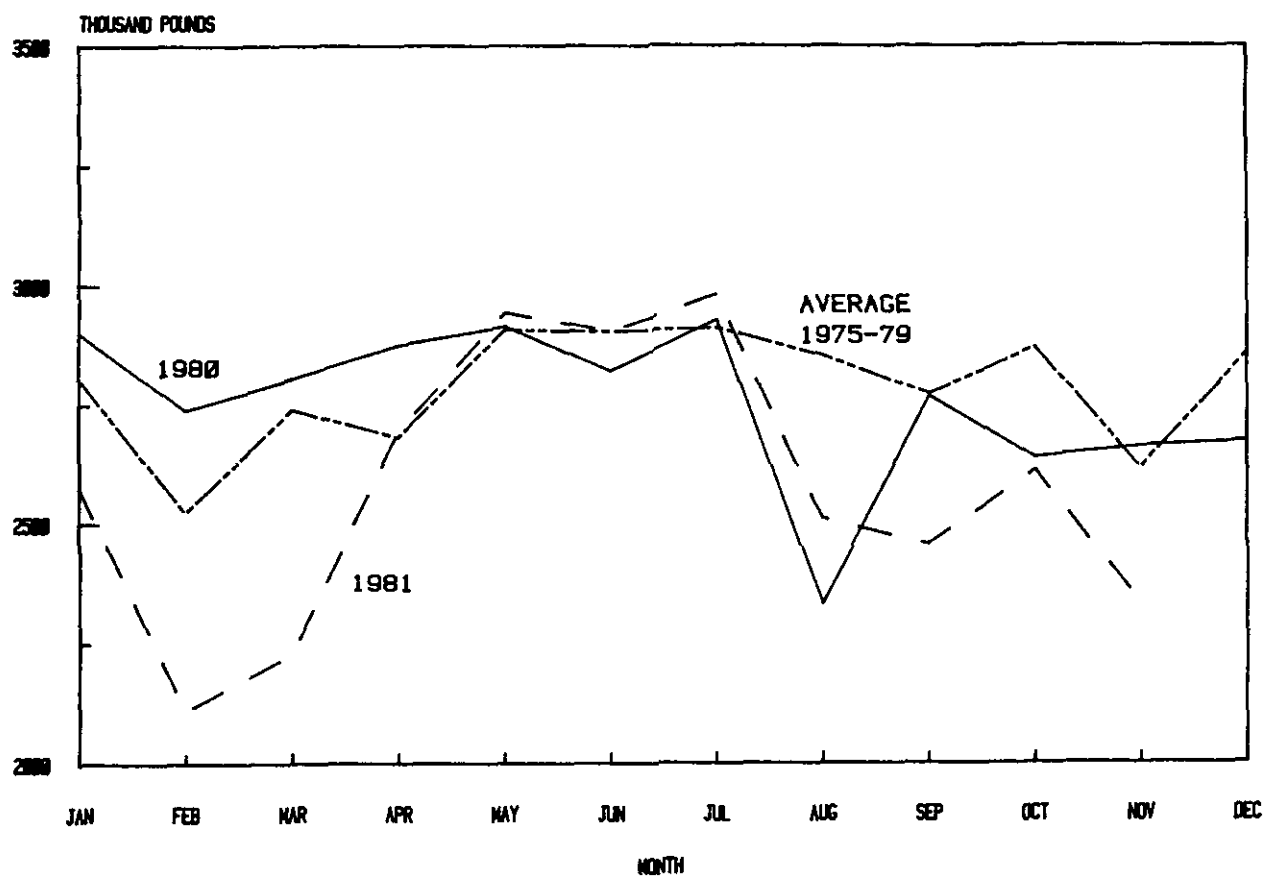
Butter and by-products, \$12.93, down 1 cent from November 1980 but 3 cents above October 1981.

American cheese, \$12.99, an increase of 6 cents from November 1980 and 6 cents above the previous month.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$13.19, up 6 cents from November 1980 and 6 cents higher than October 1981.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$12.53, 15 cents above last year and 16 cents above the previous month.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
