JULY 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 81.5 million pounds (37.0 thousand metric tons), 12 percent below July 1985 and 11 percent below June 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 244 million pounds (111 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below July last year and 7 percent below last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during July was 439 million pounds (199 thousand metric tons) about the same as July 1985 but 4 percent below last month.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 61.9 million pounds (28.1 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below July 1985 but 4 percent above June 1986.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 23.6 million pounds (10.7 thousand metric tons), 13 percent above July last year and 3 percent above last month.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 49.3 million pounds (22.3 thousand metric tons) was 18 percent below July last year and 1 percent below last month.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with July 1985)

Ice cream -- 94.5 million gallons (358 million liters), down 2 percent.

Ice milk -- 35.3 million gallons (134 million liters), up 1 percent.

Sherbet -- 5.78 million gallons (21.9 million liters), up 10 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with July 1985)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 115 million pounds (52.2 thousand metric tons), down 18 percent.

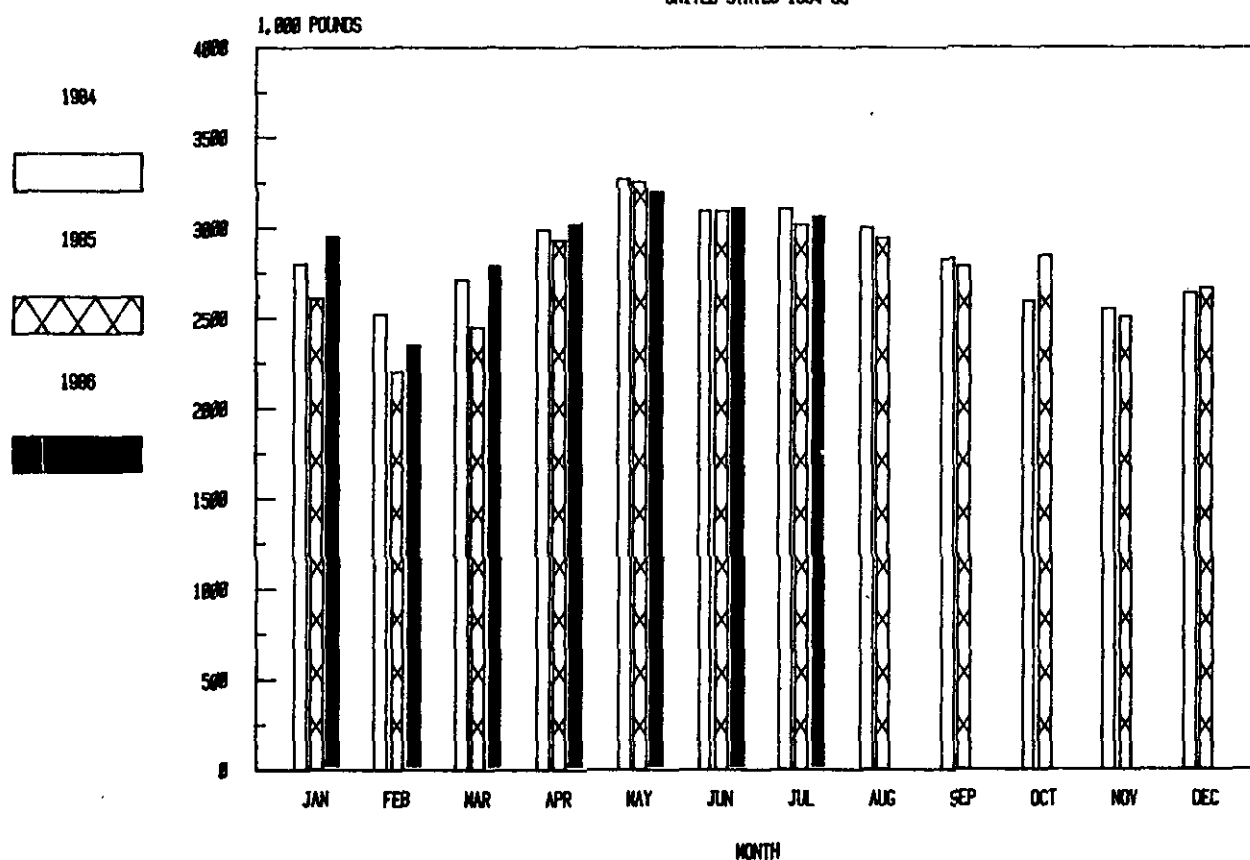
Dry whole milk -- 10.8 million pounds (4910 metric tons), up 21 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.60 million pounds (2090 metric tons), up 27 percent.
