May 1993 Highlights

Butter production was 115 million pounds in May, 3 percent below May 1992 and down 7 percent from April 1993.

American type cheese production totaled 278 million pounds. 6 percent above May 1992 and 9 percent above April 1993.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 568 million pounds. 3 percent above both May 1992 and April 1993.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 35.6 million pounds, 5 percent below May 1992 but slightly above April 1993.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 25.9 million pounds, 10 percent below May 1992 and 6 percent below April 1993.

Canned evaporated and condensed milk production at 45.9 million pounds was 11 percent below May 1992 and 1 percent below April 1993.


Frozen desserts: (comparisons with May 1992)
Ice cream (hard) --- 71.6 million gallons, down 5 percent.
Ice milk --- 34.7 million gallons, up 8 percent.
Sherbet(hard) --- 4.26 million gallons, down 5 percent.

Dry milk products: (comparisons with May 1992)
Nonfat dry milk for human food --- 104 million pounds, up 15 percent.
Dry whole milk --- 14.3 million pounds, up 5 percent.
Dry buttermilk --- 4.47 million pounds, down 13 percent.

New tables show mozzarella cheese and nonfat dry milk for human food. All tables showing States also show standard regions. However, some regions may be combined to avoid disclosure of information for individual plants. Refer to the map shown to determine the States included in the various regions.

State totals are not published when fewer than 3 firms have reported or one firm comprises more than 50 percent of the State total. The map above outlines the regions used in the product table. In the event we are not able to publish a region for confidential reasons, it will be combined with other regions when possible. For example, the New England region if not publishable separately will be combined with Middle Atlantic to form North Atlantic. If neither can be published, then both will be combined with South Atlantic to publish Atlantic. The West North Central and East North Central will be combined, if necessary, to form North Central. In the event that neither could be published, then we will combined with South to publish Central. Some tables will have only or two regions shown, therefore the regions may not add to the United States total.

Procedures and Reliability: Estimates included in this report are based on data provided by manufacturers of these products. There are 32 States where the State Departments of Agriculture assist in collection of data, which eliminates duplicate reporting and reduces respondent burden. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. There were 1,603 manufacturers that made one or more products in 1992. Reports are generally received from all dairy plants in States with small numbers of plants. In States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all large plants and from a sample of small plants. Estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of the plants which account for 70 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.

Revision Policy: Monthly production estimates are not subject to revision until the annual Dairy Products is published each May. An attempt is made to get information from all plants for preparing these estimates. Stocks data are subject to revision the following month.
