July 2005 Highlights

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 737 million pounds, 4.0 percent above July 2004 but 3.3 percent below June 2005.

American type cheese production totaled 315 million pounds, 4.2 percent above July 2004 but 1.9 percent below June 2005.

Butter production was 94.7 million pounds in July, 2.3 percent above July 2004 but 10.9 percent below June 2005.

Frozen dessert: (comparisons with July 2004)

Ice cream, Regular (hard) --- 87.6 million gallons, up 12.5 percent. Ice cream, Lowfat (total) --- 39.3 million gallons, down 7.5 percent. Ice cream, Nonfat (hard) --- 1.87 million gallons, up 8.5 percent.


Sherbet (hard) --- 5.38 million gallons, up 14.6 percent.

Frozen Yogurt (total) --- 5.64 million gallons, down 1.2 percent.

Nonfat dry milk for human food: (compared with July 2004) --- 120 million pounds, down 11.1 percent.


Dry whey products: (comparisons with June 2004) Dry whey, human --- 80.7 million pounds, up 4.7 percent. Dry whey, animal --- 7.84 million pounds, up 30.5 percent. Dry whey, total --- 88.5 million pounds, up 6.6 percent.



Procedures and Reliability: Estimates included in this report are based on data provided each month by manufacturers of these products. In 32 States, the State Departments of Agriculture assist in collection of data, which eliminates duplicate reporting and reduces respondent burden. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. There were 1,096 manufacturers that made one or more products in 2004. Each month, reports are generally received from all dairy plants in States with small numbers of plants. In States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain monthly reports from all large plants and from a sample of small plants. Monthly estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of the plants which account for 70 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.

Revision Policy: Monthly estimates are subject to revision the month following the preliminary estimates. Annual estimates are published in the "**Dairy Products**" report published each April which includes any revisions made to current and previous year. An attempt is made to get information from all plants for preparing these estimates
