#### COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING JUNE 2024

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): June came in as the second hottest June in history for this area. Despite that fact, beekeepers had a fairly good haul of honey from a productive spring bloom. Nectar supplies in June started out prolific; however, as the hot, dry days progressed, colony activity concentrated on staying cool. There were a few variable and localized rain showers in the District. Colonies are reported to be very healthy with little reports of disease or insects and good brood volumes. Nectar and pollen sources for the month were elderberry, honeysuckle, red and white clovers, basswood, sourwood, cucurbits, melons, lavender, alfalfa, euonymous, and other wildflowers.

ALABAMA: Many beekeepers reported that their colonies experienced good nectar flows throughout June. This is likely explained by much of Alabama experiencing normal temperature and moisture levels for most of the month. Near to the end of June, abnormally dry conditions crept into many regions, especially those away from the immediate coast and Florida panhandle due to above-average temperatures and reduced rainfall. Many beekeepers started extracting honey, or at least preparing for it, as well as follow-up varroa mite checks and treatments. Small hive beetle numbers began to increase, and beekeepers dealt with queenless colonies in some locations. The final early summer nectar flow came to an end sometime in June, depending on location; this was usually marked by the end of tallow flowering. Some clovers, but also sumac and crepe myrtle, bloomed. Coastal areas also saw native palms blooming.

ARIZONA: The month of June showed light rainfall throughout most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor the total precipitation for the month was .062 inches. This is .33 inches above the normal average for the month. The above average precipitation for June allowed Arizona to maintain its moderate drought status as seen last month.

Beekeepers continue honey production and strengthening the bee population numbers in hives. Pest control measures still need to be applied as hive beetles are problematic.

The demand for honey once again remains good throughout most of the state. Though the average temperatures are up, the moderate drought conditions have allowed beekeepers to get into hives and aided in processing honey. Citrus trees and various melons remain prominent pollen sources. However, there are less melons available in western Arizona with farmers transitioning to other production areas. The upcoming monsoon season will bring more moisture to the state.

ARKANSAS: During the month of June temperatures continued very high across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, most of the state had normal soil moisture. There was an area of abnormally dry to moderate drought along the Northern border of the state.

Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

#### CALIFORNIA: No report issued.

FLORIDA: Temperatures were above normal across the entire state. Precipitation was below normal in North Florida and the Panhandle but above normal in South Florida. There were few sources of natural food for the bees with supplemental feeding at time in most areas in Florida. Gallberry was available in limited quantities primarily early in the month with some palmetto around the middle of the month. Spanish Needle was blooming in parts of the Panhandle late in the month. Other sources of food were cabbage palm in North and South Florida and melaleuca and mangrove in South Florida. The month was more about survival of the bees with little honey produced for commercial uses. Hot and dry conditions existed from Central Florida northward causing some bee losses while South Florida lost bees to both dry and flooding conditions as they alternated during the month. Some beekeepers were treating for small hive beetles primarily in the Panhandle. Other beekeepers were trying to split hives in other areas with limited success. Bees were relocated to several northern states including North Carolina for sourwood honey production, the Dakotas for clover, canola and sunflower honey, Massachusetts for cranberry pollination and New York state for apple pollination. Stored supplies of honey at the end of the month were fairly light with some tupelo still awaiting test results for purity of the honey. Demand was very good for the stored tupelo with price to be determined partly by the percentage of tupelo with values over 80% receiving the highest prices.

GEORGIA: No report issued.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of June temperatures were average in Idaho. Precipitation in Idaho was normal. Utah had temperatures that were average and precipitation that was below normal. Colorado had average temperatures across the whole state, Precipitation for Colorado was below normal for June.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in June Southern Idaho had abnormally dry to moderate drought and Northern Idaho had moderate to severe drought. Utah is currently under no drought to abnormally dry conditions in Southeast Utah. Colorado had normal soil moisture to moderate drought.

Prices for the month of June were between \$2.00 and \$3.20 per pound with a mostly price of \$2.00-2.85 for Idaho, Colorado prices are too few producers reporting to determine a market. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are \$2.50-\$3.00 per pound.

ILLINOIS: In June, temperatures were cooler than usual, and rainfall was less than the historical average. Beekeepers report that most of their bees are in good condition. Beekeepers also report the bees are feeding on wildflowers, such as Honey Locust and White Dutch Clover. Honey production has started. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and slow at wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather in June was normal with less rainfall than usual. Beekeepers report that their bees continue to feed on wildflowers, such as Dutch Clover. Beekeepers report that their bees are in mostly good condition. Beekeepers report a small amount of honey flow. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: For the first part of June, Kentucky beekeepers reveled in cooler-than-normal temperatures and took advantage to harvest honey before the serious summer heat arrived. There have been reports of European foulbrood in southern KY and central Kentucky, and varroa mites are beginning to

make their presence felt with deformed wing virus symptoms in hives in the Bluegrass. The serious heat arrived around the middle of June, meaning that beekeepers cannot treat their hives for varroa mites easily now until there is a sustained period of cooler temperatures. But farmers markets throughout the region have had robust sales of honey and value-added products such as lip balms, soaps and lotions.

LOUISIANA: During the month of June temperatures were above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, normal soil moisture conditions exist across most of the state. There was an area of abnormally dry conditions in the Southeast corner. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

MICHIGAN: The Upper Peninsula of Michigan had yet another windy month in June. Above average rainfall with heavy storms, hail and flash flooding have been the norm. The rain has provided an abundance of forage for the bees but have also prevented bees from doing their work. The storms also brought a high number of power outages giving our bear friends plenty of opportunities to wreak havoc in the bee yards protected by 115 volt powered electric fences. Bear numbers are too high across the U.P. and it will only get worse without changes in the management practices. Swarm season is in full swing and honey supers are finally being installed, just in time for the basswood to bloom. Once again wildflower honey retails for \$9.00/pound.

MINNESOTA: During the month of June temperatures were average across the whole state. Precipitation for June was above normal for the North end of the state, the South end of the state saw above normal precipitation as well.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in June, Northern Minnesota had no drought and Southern Minnesota had no drought. Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.80-\$3.00 for locally sourced honey for the month of June.

MISSISSIPPI: No report issued.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: Unsettled weather for June in NYS, despite warmer than average temperatures, there were a few cool spells. Rain was diminished upstate, with 25% of topsoil too dry. There was a slow start to the honey season, but with the warm weather the bees are now packing in the nectar. Black locust nectar production was hit and miss due to the late season frost. Honey sales are strong, prices very good.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: Planting was moving forward and in line with or slightly ahead of last year. Bees were out and active as sunflower emergence (and other crops) was also about the same to slightly ahead of last year. Alfalfa development and cutting was behind last year. Water supplies were generally fairly good.

OHIO: June has been very hot and dry in Ohio. In the South Western Ohio area there has been a heavy nectar flow from various sources. Difficult to keep the brood areas of the colonies available for the queen to lay eggs. One beekeeper harvested 100 pounds of honey from his colonies two weeks ago. Central Ohio is in a nectar dearth, some Beekeepers are feeding their new colonies. Within the last 7 days western Ohio received approximately 1 inch of rain in scattered areas. Wright Patterson Air Force Base received 1 inch of rain; 15 miles north has received about one half inch of rain. Spring Feral swarm season is almost over, the primary swarms this year were very large and numerous. We were catching secondary swarms last week. It appears that honey bee nectar sources this year were about 2-3 weeks earlier than usual. Early soybeans are starting to bloom about 2-3 weeks earlier this year. With 1000's of acres of soybeans in western Ohio, Beekeepers will have to be very careful and provide surplus honey space for the nectar. With the wet weather during bean planting farmers had a difficult time planting seeds. With early, mid, late and extra late beans, this year western Ohio beekeepers may have a record honey production year in 2024. More rain is forecast for July 4 and 5.

Nectar flow was variable around the state with moisture in some northwestern counties and heat with high humidity for about a week throughout the state. Cleveland reached a low of 44 F in mid-June then peaked at 96 F six days later and was 1.25 inches above the 3.70-inch normal rainfall. A similar pattern occurred in the Youngstown area (NE corner) but was almost 2" below normal in rainfall. The sum of rainfall in Columbus was 3" below normal with 6 consecutive days of temperatures above 90 F. Cincinnati (SW) temperature averaged 86 F receiving a deficit of 1.75 rainfall below normal.

Linden trees bloomed early and lasted long enough for some areas to receive a good honey crop. Rose-of-Sharon is in full bloom in Central Ohio. The panicled Goldenraintree is flowering in Northern Ohio expecting Rose-of-Sharon to bloom soon. In southwestern Ohio, most of the major flowering trees and shrubs have finished blooming, but many perennials are just beginning to flourish.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of June temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, East and Central Oklahoma had normal soil moisture. It was abnormally dry to severe drought conditions throughout the panhandle. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: Tennessee has been experiencing a dearth in nectar during the month of June. The higher than average temperatures and dry weather conditions halted the clover nectar flow early in June. Sourwood is starting to bloom and is producing some nectar. There are a few areas that are seeing asters producing some nectar. Honey production for the year so far has been below average. Beekeepers that have extracted their honey from the spring are now selling this year's honey. Retail prices of honey range from \$16.00 a pound for wildflower honey and up to \$36.00 per pound for some varietal honey.

TEXAS: During the month of June temperatures were above normal across most of the state. Precipitation during May was well below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Eastern and North central had normal soil moisture. Abnormally dry to severe drought

conditions covered the area from South Central to West Texas with an area of extreme drought still in an area West of San Antonio. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: June started off with some precipitation around the state, though not much in the Central portion of the state. Dry weather saw some brush fires on non-irrigated lands. Some folks were evacuated but crops were not damaged. Cherry harvest began in the earliest areas. Mid-June the apricot harvest was beginning. The weather began to warm up with more brush fires. Some rain and/or high winds were reported limiting bee activity. The wind generally continued, through the end of the month with warming temperatures. Cherry harvest continued while crews worked on thinning other tree fruits. Hops were almost to the tops of their trellises/ mint harvest began and hay was being cut. Some floral sources included wildflowers in slightly higher elevations.

WISCONSIN: Temperatures were slightly cooler for June with slightly more rainfall than normal. For the most part, beekeepers report a normal, healthy population of bees. Beekeepers report wild foliage for their bees includes Clover, wild parsnips, Basswood and Black Mustard and other wildflowers. Honey production has started. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
