COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING OCTOBER 2024

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): After some rain showers in late September, the rain was short lived. October in the Appalachian District produced no to very minimal rain and the area is in a severe drought. The District did not experience a hard freeze in October, but many pocket areas did have several frosts. Colony condition is variable with a few beekeepers reporting some colonies failed due to starvation. Many did apply supplemental food earlier in the fall season than normal due to the dearth in bloom and lack of water and those colonies are managing well. Although bloom has pretty much dried up for most wildflowers, the warmer temperatures and drought conditions did result in very light and sporadic bloom of various spring blooming shrubs especially in the lower elevations.

ALABAMA: Alabama experienced a dry month, with most of the state reporting abnormally dry or moderate drought conditions for all of October. Temperatures swung from above average in early October to below average during the middle to late parts of the month. Alabama was relatively spared from the hurricanes that devastated other parts of the region. Most beekeepers fed their colonies and made other standard preparations in anticipation of winter, especially since the goldenrod started to shut down mid to late October. Other plants that bloomed included frost aster, sneeze weed, and salvia. Beekeepers monitored for the varroa mite and performed fall treatments; reports of very high amounts of small hive beetle occurred. A monitoring program of capped brood presence, coordinated by multiple regional university and government agencies, revealed plenty of capped brood in colonies in the state.

ARIZONA: The month of October 2024 showed slightly hotter than normal temperatures for this time of year. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor Arizona has remained in Moderate drought conditions throughout most of the state. The higher elevations of Northern Arizona do provide some moisture and relief to these arid conditions.

This month was the 43rd driest October on record (dating back to 1895). There was 0.43 inches of total precipitation for the month. This is a decrease of 0.46 inch from the average or normal.

The demand for honey remains good throughout most of the state. Desert bloom and cotton are among the main sources of pollen. There are also some cantaloupes, honeydews and certain citrus. To supplement feeding, some beekeepers have also resorted to using more concentrated pollen patties. Beekeepers are optimistic heading into winter months.

ARKANSAS: During the month of October temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well below normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, the Northeast corner had normal soil moisture, and the rest of the state had abnormally dry to severe drought conditions. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: No report issued.

FLORIDA: No report issued.

GEORGIA: For October there was light rain overall, temperatures began to drop lower ranging from 68 to 88 F. Some loss to hives due to wind and rain. Production was good with good yields. More availability of honey at lower prices. The focus now is to sustain the bee health/colony. Beekeepers fed their colonies to prepare for the cold months ahead.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of October temperatures were average in Idaho. Precipitation in Idaho was below normal. Utah had temperatures that were average and precipitation that was below normal. Colorado had average temperatures across the whole state, Precipitation for Colorado was below normal for October.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in October Southern Idaho had no drought to severe drought and Northern Idaho had moderate to severe drought. Utah is currently under abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions. Colorado had normal soil moisture to extreme drought.

ILLINOIS: The weather for October has been good overall and there is a need for more rain. Treatment for mites has begun. The bees are in good condition as they go out on cleansing flights. Some foliage still remains, such as white and purple aster and a few goldenrods. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather for October has been good with many warm days with above average temperatures and below average rainfall. Beekeepers report their bees in good condition and prepared for winter. Some beekeepers continued supplemental feeding of their bees. Beekeepers with mite problems have begun treating their hives. Demand for honey is good and demand exceeded supply at the retail level and demand was fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: Kentucky had the fourth driest October in recorded history. It was also one of the warmer October months, so there were still plenty of goldenrod, smartweed, asters, sunflowers and a few coneflowers as the month closed. Honeybees took advantage of this unexpected and unseasonal weather by bringing in nectar and pollen, although brood production had predictably slowed considerably. Beekeepers were installing mouse-guards and entrance reducers as the season was winding down. Sales of honey remain strong throughout the state.

LOUISIANA: During the month of October temperatures were above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, abnormally dry to severe conditions covered the state. There was an area of normal soil moisture in the Southeast corner. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

MICHIGAN: October turned out to be just an extension of late summer with unusually warm temperatures and continued drought. Wildfires are the main concern in Michigan's Upper Peninsula with many fires already burning. This is a rare problem in the UP as we usually have wet and snowy weather in October. It has been great weather for our bees. Every day filling our feeders gives us a better chance of making it through winter. Any day now we will have to protect our hives from the cold winter winds. Many different methods of insulating and winter feeding are utilized across the UP. A

bear took both of my fences down last week, fortunately the charge was enough to chase off the bear and the hives were spared. Wildflower honey retails for \$9.00/pound.

MINNESOTA: During the month of October temperatures were average across the whole state. Precipitation for October was below normal for the North end of the state, the South end of the state also had below normal precipitation.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in October, Northern Minnesota had abnormally dry conditions to severe drought and Southern Minnesota also had abnormally dry conditions to severe drought.

MISSISSIPPI: During October temperatures were above average with highs of 88F and lows of 68 F. Production was good, plenty of volume available at slightly lower prices. Beekeepers are preparing the colonies for the cooler winter months ahead.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: Dry conditions persist throughout the state, with the eastern/Hudson valley, Long Island, and southwestern regions in NY abnormally dry. Beekeepers are extracting the last honey harvested for the year. The bees are still flying with the warm temperatures, but there is no longer any significant bloom; beekeepers may have to check the colonies' winter stores more frequently. Honey sales very good.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: Generally dry weather in October saw moisture supplies continue to decrease and were generally short to adequate. Harvest for most items was generally in line with the averages. Sunflowers harvest was slightly behind at the beginning of the month but ahead by the end of the month. By the end of the month the potato harvest was generally completed. Stock water and soil moisture was generally fair to good. Bees were being prepared for winter either at home or down South.

OHIO: Need a total of 5 inches rain within Ohio, very dry, a few cold fronts crossed over Ohio but did not produce much rainfall, light showers. Many Beekeepers feeding their bees sugar or fondant because of the drought many experienced beekeepers are also feeding protein, in patties and also protein Flour feeders only source of pollen and nectar is the aster families, most areas of Ohio have nothing for the foragers to find. Reports of package bees and Nuc colonies, from the south, many have been absconding. Not sure of the causes. The Ohio Feral honey bees are in good health, they continue to keep the mite populations very low by damaging them in several ways. Because of the low mite populations, the bees typically have low or no viruses. Many beekeepers keep bees in areas that is to their advantage, but not the honey bees advantage. Which creates problems for the bees. There are several programs that are assisting landowners to plant pollinator flowers. The interest in planting pollinator flowers is increasing. Our work at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base is on going, this year we had approximately 900 acres of flowers blooming starting in May to October. The drought had a negative impact on some of the flowers. The base has an early mowing schedule plus Controlled Burns on Huffman Prairie and others areas of the base. Continuing education is required and essential for farmers and landowners. Soybeans in Ohio provided a major nectar flow for bees this year. Most farmers don't know about the value of nectar for bees plus also an increase in bean yields for the farmer. Honey prices have remained stable: \$5.50 to \$6.00. Retail \$9.00 to \$16.00. Beeswax is selling at \$8.00 to \$16.00. Propolis is selling at \$15.00 per ounce.

Generally, October remained warm and dry except for some counties in southeast Ohio that were affected by Hurricane Helene. Specifically portions of southern Ohio from Portsmouth (Scioto County) to Chillicothe (Ross County) reported damage from high winds and flooding. Although wind and large amounts of rainfall made a swath going Northeast across the state, the most extensive damage was in the southern portion. Northern Ohio remains in "severe drought" while the southern half is under moderate drought. Many beekeepers have reported colonies absconding while robbing continues. Most floral resources have finished, yet with the warm temperatures, the bees are eating their stores. The time to feed syrup to bees is quickly fading. Mite control should continue, although by now, infested colonies may not survive.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of October temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, conditions were reversed from normal. East and Central Oklahoma had mostly severe to extreme drought conditions covered that part of the state. The panhandle had mostly normal soil moisture conditions. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: The nectar and pollen sources for TN during the month of October were Goldenrod and Asters. We know we had some losses due to Hurricane Helene in Upper East TN, both in the terms of colonies and honey processing facilities. We do not have an accurate number of colonies or beekeepers affected at this time due to issues with communication within that region.

TEXAS: During the month of October temperatures were well above normal across much of the state. Precipitation during October was well below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, East Texas had moderate to severe drought conditions. North Central Texas had severe to extreme drought conditions. South Central Texas had abnormally dry to severe conditions with an area extreme drought West of San Antonio. West Texas had abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions with far West Texas under extreme drought conditions.

There was still a lot of blooms across most of Texas to feed the temporary bees getting ready to move to California. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: Conditions were generally dry early in the month although as the month progressed the Western portion of the state got some substantial moisture. Harvest continued for late season items such as apples. Hops and fall corn were completed and potatoes were generally finished by

the end of the month. Some light frost was reported later in the month. The mountains received a little snow later in the month but only at the higher elevations. Bees at home were being prepared for over wintering.

WISCONSIN: The weather has been good for October with nice in the earlier part of the month and the later part turning cold. Wisconsin has had average rainfall. Beekeepers continue to test for mites and those showing them present are being treated. Beekeepers report that there are 7 Sons Tree, late asters, and goldenrods for their bees. Some beekeepers have finished feeding their bees, while others continue to feed them. Most beekeepers report that their bees are in fair to good condition. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
