COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING MAY 2024

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): May was a very busy month as colonies focused on brood rearing and honey production after an active swarm period. The weather was fairly wet with sporadic storms for the first half of the month, but soon drier weather prevailed and bloom was excellent. A few beekeepers needed to procure local replacement queens and by the end of the month an occasional beekeeper was extracting honey. Nectar and pollen were readily available all month from black locust, tulip poplar, black cherry, white and yellow clovers, dandelion, apples, ailanthus, black gum, blackberries, and various other brambles and wildflowers.

ALABAMA: The month of May began warmer than usual, with some abnormally dry conditions in the northeast part of the state. By the end of the month, normal temperatures were observed, as well as usual precipitation and soil moisture conditions. Good nectar flow was reported throughout the state, with beekeepers frequenting supering their colonies to allow for space for honey storage and to minimize swarming. Swarming reduced, especially in southern parts of the state; however, this behavior continued in more central and northern parts as the nectar flow continued. Tallow bloomed in southern portions of Alabama during the second and third weeks of May. Clover was present in many areas, especially during the beginning of May during cooler conditions. Plants such as coreopsis and bidens also bloomed.

ARIZONA: The month of May showed very little rainfall throughout most of the state. The rainfall for the year-to-date is still above average compared to previous years however. According to the Arizona Department of Water Resources, the precipitation of recent months has moved Arizona from a Severe (D2) into a Moderate (D1) Drought status.

Hives have fully returned from out-of-state pollination trips. Beekeepers are in full swing with honey production and strengthening the bee population numbers in hives. Beekeepers still need to be concerned with hive beetles and other pests. Regular inspections can help alleviate these potential issues with months to come.

The demand for honey once again remains good throughout most of the state. The increased rainfall over the last few months has aided in bringing many flowering plants to full bloom. Citrus trees, various melons and cactus bloom are the most prevalent pollen sources. The upcoming monsoon season will bring more moisture to the state.

ARKANSAS: During the month of May temperatures were very high across most of the state. Precipitation was well above normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, most of the state had normal soil moisture. There was an area of abnormally dry to moderate drought in the Northeast corner of the state.

Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: No report issued.

FLORIDA: Temperatures were above normal across the state with much above normal readings in parts of Central and South Florida. Precipitation was above normal in the Panhandle and below normal in the Peninsula. Bee health was good in the Panhandle and North and about average in Central and South Florida. A few collapsed colonies were reported in Central and South Florida. The cause of the collapses is presently unknown. Gallberry and tupelo flow was good in the Panhandle and North Florida with tupelo honey production expected to be the highest in the last few years. Titi was also available in the Panhandle with some palmetto available in the North. Even under dry, hot conditions palmetto, gallberry and Spanish Needle were in pretty good shape in most of Central and South Florida with a reasonable amount of honey production. Cabbage palm began blooming on the east coast late in the month. Some bees from all over the state were being relocated to more northern states mostly for pollination purposes. Some were sent to produce clover honey in North or South Dakota while others were pollinating cranberries and other vegetables in Michigan, Wisconsin and New York. Most of the tupelo honey produced was still being stored at the end of the month with bottlers and beekeepers negotiating pricing. Other types of honey were also being stored with beekeepers hoping to receive better prices in a few weeks. Demand for Florida honey was very good at the end of the month with moderate amounts of stored honey.

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Plant Industry (FDACS-DPI) has recently opened the Honey Bee Diagnostic Laboratory (HBDL) in Gainesville. This lab provides a menu of diagnostic tests and provides services that only a handful of facilities in the United States offer. Its services are available to Florida beekeepers and beekeepers from any other state in the country. More information can be obtained by calling FDACS-DPI Helpline at 1-888-397-1517.

GEORGIA: No report issued.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of May temperatures were average in Idaho. Precipitation in Idaho was normal. Utah had temperatures that were average and precipitation that was normal. Colorado had average temperatures across the whole state, Precipitation for Colorado was normal for May.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in May Southern Idaho had no drought and Northern Idaho had moderate to severe drought. Utah is currently under no drought to abnormally dry conditions in Southeast Utah. Colorado had normal soil moisture to moderate drought in Southwestern Colorado.

Prices for the month of May were between \$2.20 and \$3.20 per pound with a mostly price of \$2.20-2.85 for Idaho, Colorado prices are too few producers reporting to determine a market. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are \$2.50-\$3.00 per pound.

ILLINOIS: Temperatures for the month of May were slightly above normal with an average amount of rainfall. Although rainfall was average, it came in sustained and prolonged time periods. Beekeepers report that their bees are in good to excellent condition. Beekeepers also report the bees are feeding on wildflowers, such as Basswood, Sweet Clover, and White Dutch Clover. Some beekeepers received their packaged bees later than normal this year, and therefore they have begun supplemental feeding of the bees with protein patties. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and slow at wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: Temperatures for the month of May were higher than average overall. Rainfall in most parts of the state was above average for this time of the year. Beekeepers report that their bees continue to feed on wildflowers, such as White Dutch Clover and Black Locust. Beekeepers report their bees

are in good condition. Some beekeepers report that honey flow has started. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: Kentucky beekeepers welcomed a new state apiarist on May 01st, Dr. Amanda Skidmore with Kentucky Department of Agriculture.

Many beekeepers have enjoyed a bountiful May, already harvesting and making queen bees, although there have been a few reports of European foulbrood.

LOUISIANA: During the month of May temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well above normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, normal soil moisture conditions exist across most of the state.

Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

MICHIGAN: May in Michigan's Upper Peninsula was as usual, mostly cool with a couple of warm days mixed in. It was a wet month with the rain being very welcome with the current drought conditions. Even with the rain the fire dangers remain very high for most of the Upper Peninsula. It has been another windy month, steady winds with high gusts.

There is no shortage of food for the bees. There is still an abundance of trees and shrubs that are in bloom and some spring flowers have finally arrived. Another year with our packaged bees arriving in early May. First major honey flow comes from the Basswood trees, and they are only a few weeks away from flowering. Wildflower honey retails for \$9.00/pound.

MINNESOTA: During the month of May temperatures were average across the whole state. Precipitation for May was above normal for the North end of the state, the South end of the state saw above normal precipitation as well.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in May, Northern Minnesota had no drought to abnormally dry soil moisture and Southern Minnesota had no drought.

Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.80-\$3.00 for locally sourced honey for the month of May.

MISSISSIPPI: No report issued.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: Warmer than average temperatures persist, with topsoil and subsoil moisture adequate, despite lack of winter snowmelt in New York. Chestnut, Black Locust trees, and blackberries have bloomed. Many colonies are swarming. Beekeepers are struggling to keep up and make splits of strong colonies. Bear activity is also up. Honey sales and prices reported to be good and stable.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: In May bees were finishing crops in other areas, such as the Pacific Northwest where most of the tree fruit was finishing bloom. Hives were moving back home where conditions were generally good. Plantings were somewhat ahead of schedule and moisture supplies generally good. With good weather many crops were ahead on emergence as well.

OHIO: Ohio weather was raining and warm which allowed many flowers to grow sooner than usual, allowing forager bees to load up on both pollen and nectar. Reports are saying beekeepers are harvesting honey and trying to keep their colonies from swarming because of the early warm weather plus high amounts of pollen and nectar. Feral Colonies started to swarm in Early April. The Feral Swarm Trapping team have had great success in trapping feral bees this year. Some beekeepers have caught 50 plus swarms themselves in very remote areas. The price of honey has remained stable from the previous many months.

Ohio has had the unfortunate record of having the most or one of the most tornadoes in the United States this year. According to the National Weather Service, as of May 31, 2024, 67 tornadoes have hit The Buckeye State, seven of which were EF2 or higher. Rainfall varied from being above normal (Cincinnati- 2-3"), average (Mansfield) or below normal (Cleveland- 2"). Cleveland's average temperature for May was 75 F with lows at night down to 43F. The temperature peaked at 90 F on May 21. Youngstown's temperature peaked at 87F on May 20, but dropped to 38 the evening of May 11. Total rainfall measured at 5.65"- well above the normal amount of 3.60 inches. The Cincinnati Area reached 88F for three days in a row (May 19-21). While the "Normal" rainfall is 4.55", it received 7.40 this month.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of May temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, East and Central Oklahoma had normal soil moisture. It was abnormally dry to severe drought conditions throughout the panhandle.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: In Tennessee the major nectar flows have been clover and tulip poplar, the nectar flow was below average due to persistent rain throughout the month. No major pest or disease issues reported. In western Tennessee they have been seeing a few cases of European Foulbrood.

TEXAS: During the month of May temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation during April was below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Eastern and North central had normal soil moisture. Abnormally dry to severe drought conditions covered the area from South Central to West Texas with an area of extreme drought still in an area West of San Antonio.

Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: May started out a bit chilly but improved by mid-May. Tree fruits were finished blooming, and the sets were generally good. Grapes and hops were beginning to take off while other field crop plantings were underway. Milder weather was also dry later in the month. and some alfalfa was getting it's first cutting. The weather cooled later in the month and remained dry with freezing temperatures in a few areas. Seasonal wildflower blooms were starting at lower elevations in the mountains.

WISCONSIN: Temperatures for the month of May were warm with lots of rain. Most Beekeepers report a normal, healthy population of bees, while others say they are starting with a smaller population and are waiting for the bees to build up their numbers. Beekeepers report wild foliage for their bees includes Black Locust and other wildflowers. Honey flow has started. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
