COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING NOVEMBER 2023

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): For most of November, the Appalachian District was very dry and parts were experiencing a severe drought. It was most severe in the VA part of the District whereas the northern area had adequate moisture. By the end of the month, the area had received rains alleviating most of the drought status. Temperatures in the District were mostly seasonable, cooling off a bit near the end of the month. If they had not already done so, Beekeepers made final colony preparations for the winter. Many hobbyists were busy promoting and selling honey and related items for the upcoming holidays.

ALABAMA: Alabama experienced substantial swings in temperature during the month of November. Early in the month saw below average temperatures; however, by the middle of the month the state experienced above average temperatures. Despite changes in temperatures, nearly the entire state experienced drought-like conditions. The most extreme cases occurred in the northern and southern parts of Alabama. As a result, forage was likely affected, which forced many beekeepers to feed their colonies sugar syrup more than usual to ensure they had enough carbohydrate stores to last through winter. In southern parts of the state, camellias and bidens were in bloom; central and northern parts of the state had some blooming dandelions and henbit. A regional brood monitoring program revealed that capped brood was present in colonies throughout the month; however, amounts declined substantially near the end of the month. Most beekeepers were planning their winter varroa management activities, and how they can make repairs to their woodenware and other equipment in the near future.

ARIZONA: The month of November continued to show hotter than normal temperatures for this time of year. The drought conditions seen last month are still present. Though some rain did occur during the month, the majority of the Arizona counties suffered a reduction in rainfall compared to previous years at this month-to-date. Many of these are the lowest amount of moisture for November spanning decades.

The persistent dry conditions have limited production of honey. According to beekeeping sources, many citrus trees were left barren from persistent dry conditions. With little or no flowers produced for bees to collect pollen, correlations can be drawn to lessened honey production.

The demand for honey once again remains good throughout most of the state. Desert melons, cotton and cacti flowers are among the main sources of pollen. This high demand for honey is related to the decrease in available pollen sources brought on by drier than normal conditions. Also, with the holidays coming up some beekeepers take breaks in honey harvesting and production.

ARKANSAS: During the month of November temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well below normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Arkansas had mostly normal soil moisture across most of the state. There is an area of moderate to severe drought in Southeastern Arkansas. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: California beekeepers reported lower prices for honey as they moved hives to winter pastures this November. They also remained concerned that pollination fees for this year's almond crop could drop as more orchards are removed from production due to low markets and water restrictions. "The situation is dynamic," said a beekeeper who attended the American Honey Producers Association conference in early December. "Orchards are being taken out in the San Joaquin Valley due to the Sustainable Groundwater Act in California. Plenty of planting and replanting in the Sacramento Valley. The almond industry thinks that it will take about three years for nut prices to increase, due to the huge carryover. A bad crop would help overall." Almond growers faced with lower demand may try "to pinch every penny," he said.

Meanwhile, above average rainfall in California helped make 2023 a "decent" year for honey production in the state, though overall honey markets weakened. "The bees made enough honey for winter, and in some cases too much, blocking the brood chamber," a beekeeper said. "We are pulling some frames heavy with honey and pollen and giving the queen open frames to lay in. The area we are in rarely ceases brood rearing, and the queens need room to lay eggs."

Some beekeepers continued to feed protein and sugar syrup when necessary to help ensure an adequate population of young bees in the winter cluster. Varroa mites caused extensive damage for some hives this season. Beekeepers' chances of treating colonies were limited by extreme heat and honey flows earlier this year. "We need the queens to keep laying eggs," a beekeeper said. "Pray for rain!"

Going forward, beekeepers are hoping for another wet year with abundant floral sources for bees. As honey prices remain low, beekeepers may be more eager for pollination fees, despite concerns over lower almond demand. One beekeeper noted that if honey prices increase, transportation costs to California could limit out-of-state beekeepers from bringing their hives in for almond pollination. "But as with every year, we won't know until early February," he said.

FLORIDA: Temperatures and precipitation were about normal for the month with a few cooler than average days primarily in North Florida. Bee health was considered to be good with most bees not needing any supplemental feeding. Wildflowers were generally available around the state with Spanish Needle and Astor in most areas. The Panhandle area also had good supplies of Goldenrod which led to some wildflower honey production above the needs of the hives. Most beekeepers were increasing hive numbers but waiting to split until early December. Some were treating for mites, but many were also waiting until December to treat. Brazilian Pepper honey was still being pulled from hives in Central and South Florida early in the month. Pepper honey production appeared to be about average when compared to previous years not counting the hurricane ravaged crop from last year. There was good demand for any stored honey at the end of the month. Most stored honey was Brazilian Pepper in Central and South Florida and wildflower honey in the Panhandle with fairly light supplies of either.

GEORGIA: At the state meeting with the Georgia Farm Bureau, beekeepers report they are in short supplies for wholesale buyers. In South Georgia the last storm that went through dumped excess water all at once and that cut supplies as well. California is asking more people to go out there with their bees. Many will not make the trek out West this year due to the combined expenses of transportation and maintaining the hives while there. Wholesale honey reported at \$4 lb by bucket and \$3 lb by barrel.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of November temperatures were normal in Idaho. Precipitation in Idaho was normal for the West side of the state, the east side of the state had above normal precipitation. Utah had temperatures that were normal and precipitation that was a little above normal. Colorado had normal temperatures across the whole state, Precipitation for Colorado was a little below normal.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in November Idaho had no drought to an area of moderate to severe drought in Northern Idaho. Utah is currently under no drought to abnormally dry conditions in Southeast Utah. Colorado had normal soil moisture to severe drought in western Colorado.

During the month of November producers have their hives either in storage, wrapped for winter or in warmer climates waiting for almond pollination.

Prices for the month of November were between \$2.85 and \$3.20 per pound with a mostly price of \$3.00 for Idaho. Colorado prices are too few producers reporting to determine a market. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are \$2.80-\$3.30 per pound with mostly \$3.00 to \$3.30.

ILLINOIS: The weather for November has had warmer temperatures than usual, with very little precipitation. Generally, the bees are in good condition. Beekeepers have treated for mites. No foliage remains. The bees are ready for winter. Demand for honey is pretty good at the retail level and only fair at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather for November has been slightly warmer than average, and with very little precipitation. Beekeepers report their bees in good condition. Few beekeepers continued supplemental feeding of their bees. No foliage remains. The bees are ready for winter. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and demand was fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: After an exceptionally chilly end to October, Kentucky beekeepers enjoyed some milder, but rainy weather in November. Many honey producers found healthy markets for their products as holiday shoppers wanted to support local producers by buying honey, candles or other beeswax items. Few hive inspections were reported, and no diseases reported this month, due to the holiday season and rainy conditions of November.

LOUISIANA: During the month of November temperatures were about normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, most of the state continues to be experiencing extreme to exceptional drought. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

MICHIGAN: No report issued.

MINNESOTA: During the month of November temperatures were normal across the whole state. Precipitation for November was far below normal for the South end of the state, the North end of the state saw a little below average precipitation.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in November the whole state had abnormally dry to severe dry soil moisture.

During the month of November producers have their hives either in storage, wrapped for winter or in warmer climates waiting for almond pollination.

Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.80-\$3.00 with mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.00 for locally sourced honey for the month of November.

MISSISSIPPI: No report issued.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: November had average to above average temperatures, but the end of the month brought snowfall and colder temperatures. Western NY continues to have below normal precipitation conditions. Beekeepers finishing up winter preparations: wrapping hives and applying oxalic acid treatment for varroa mite to control during the broodless winter season. Some reports of fall colony loss to possible varroa/virus, and queen loss. Honey sales strong, prices very good.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: Harvest for most crops were generally complete. Hives were moved to their overwinter locations. Water supplies were generally adequate going into early winter. Improved from some of the droughts in recent years.

OHIO: The month of November saw the continued dry weather in Ohio. Over the month Ohio received a total of 2 inches. The Ohio Drought Monitor shows 43% are abnormally dry. The last 3 weeks of the pollinator flower bloom was extremely dry in October. Because of the low rain fall, honeybees did not have adequate pollen to store for brood rearing starting in late December when honeybee queens starting laying eggs after the Winter Equinox when the angle of the sun starts moving North. Many Ohio beekeepers are feeding protein flour in feeders for the colony foragers to take back to the colonies to store.

November temperatures were above 50 degrees most days until the last 6 days of the month. Many beekeepers were feeding carbohydrates during November. Many reports of dead honeybee colonies were reported in November, plus failing queens were numerous. Commercial beekeepers were getting ready to ship their colonies to California to begin the process of pollinating Almond trees in the coming 2024 spring. Honey prices are \$5.50 - \$6.00 pound wholesale, \$9.00 - \$16.00 retail.

November has been cool, damp and cloudy, but warm enough that the bees have been flying searching for food. In Cleveland, the average temperature was 53.5 degrees F, ranging from 29- 68 F. Rainfall was 1.22 inches less than normal. Similarly, Southwestern Ohio (Cincinnati region) temperatures ranged from 17-79 degrees, with an average temperature of 56.6 F degrees. Rainfall was 1.61" below normal. Reports of colony loss, even among commercial beekeepers have already occurred.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of November temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was about normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Oklahoma had mostly normal soil moisture across most of the state. There are scattered areas of

moderate to severe drought scattered across the southern part of the state. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: Prices for South Carolina honey sold at the State Farmers Market in West Columbia, SC reported: 12/1 Pint at \$70.00-75.00, 12/1 Quart at \$110.00-130.00, 12 count. Honey Bears at \$40.00-48.00, 4/1 Gallon at \$180.00 and 1 Gallon at \$50.00.

TENNESSEE: November in Tennessee did not produce any significant sources of nectar or pollen. A few beekeepers are reporting absconding losses. Absconding colonies have no adult bees remaining, plenty of stored honey and pollen, no dead bees in or around the colonies, and some have small patches of abandoned worker brood remaining. Most of these incidences have been reported to occur when temperatures are below 40 degrees when the bees should not have been flying. Other than that rare issue most of the colonies in the state are in good shape to overwinter.

TEXAS: During the month of November temperatures were about normal across most of the state. Precipitation during November was below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, much of the state has normal to moderate drought. There is an area around San Antonio of moderate extreme drought. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: Early cool weather was accompanied by rain across the state. Rain lessened later in the month as most field work was completed. Some snow in received in higher elevations in the Cascades and some lower elevations also had some light snow or rain.

WISCONSIN: November has had warmer temperatures and less than a third of the normal amount of precipitation. Beekeepers have prepared for the winter. Beekeepers report that there is no more wild foliage for their bees. Most beekeepers report no problems with insects and some have finished treatment for mites. Some beekeepers have finished feeding their bees, while a few others continue to feed them. Most beekeepers report that their bees are in good condition and are ready for winter. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
