COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING DECEMBER 2023

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): December brought some precipitation in the form of rain, which was needed in some parts of the District as the dearth in some areas due to arid soils varied from area to area in the District. Temperatures were on the mild side for the most part with some beekeepers even reporting some bees were actually making flights in December. Beekeepers reported this year overall was not as nectar plentiful as in past years. Honey flow was moderate to good depending on colony location and when the dearth began. A few beekeepers were selling or purchasing equipment in December and placing orders for new spring bees. A couple were testing early holiday gifts of thermal imagers to locate colony clusters on the cold days. Beginner beekeeper classes and nucs and splits class registrations were announced and will occur in January. The MD Department of

Agriculture caught three honeybee swarms at the port of Baltimore. The swarms were of unknown origin and were eradicated. In addition to the port of Baltimore, the MDA also has swarm traps placed at BWI Thurgood Marshall airport and the Fed Ex and Amazon compounds. They monitor for any Apis species and their parasites that may have hitched a ride on shipments. The Eastern Apiculture Society (EAS) 2024 conference is being held in Maryland on August 5-9 for the first time in 20 years, which has beekeepers in the state buzzing with excitement.

ALABAMA: December started off with above average temperatures and a moderate drought in northern parts of the state; plants like henbit and dandelions were visited by bees. By the third week of December, bitter cold temperatures arrived, and southern portions of the state experienced drought-like conditions. These cold temperatures meant that bees were not departing from their colonies often, and there was little to no forage available. Most colonies likely possessed some capped brood throughout the month of December, especially given that cold temperatures came during the latter half of the month. Anticipating low brood, some beekeepers treated with oxalic acid. Beekeepers also regularly checked their food stores, especially in anticipation of the forecasted cold weather at the end of December.

ARIZONA: The month of December 2023 showed some progress with increased rainfall compared to previous months. According to the Arizona State Climate Office, the rainfall at about 1 inch for the month was the highest of any month of the year. Though encouraging, the majority of the state is still suffering from drought conditions. Mohave, Maricopa, as well as portions of Cocorino, Pinal and Pima counties are among the most severe with drought conditions.

According to beekeeping sources, much of the foraging for pollen has halted. The limited foraging and many beekeepers taking time off for the holiday season, have significantly lessened honey production this month and depleted honey reserves.

The demand for honey once again remains good throughout most of the state. The limited foraging has caused the majority of beekeepers to "winterize" and use pollen patties for food sources for their bees. Preparations for some are being made to transport hives to bordering states (e.g. California) in upcoming months for pollination.

ARKANSAS: During the month of December temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well below normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, it was abnormally dry from the Northwest corner down through Central Arkansas. From Central Arkansas South it was severe drought to extreme drought to the Southeast corner. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: Honey prices remained low for December, and so could almond pollination fees ahead, according to California beekeepers. "Some growers are complaining about high pollination prices and low almond prices and are trying to get a price reduction for pollination," a beekeeper said.

Conditions of hives across the state varied. "Here in northern California, the weather has been mild, and most beekeepers I've spoken with are pretty happy with their bees," another beekeeper said. Still, winter was slow to arrive, which could lead to a shorter brood break and higher mite counts next season. Damage was more severe for others, despite efforts to bolster colony strength by regularly feeding hives with protein patties. "The weather was cool, and the bees did eat the patties," a beekeeper said. "It does not look as if most of the colonies gained much strength. There was some natural pollen coming in during the few hours of fly time. The days are getting longer, and we should see more improvement." His winter losses were roughly 50 to 60 percent, with most from 2023 queens. "Most of them just failed, but there was some noticeable mite damage," he said. "We are seeing a mite build up now and plan to treat soon."

Lower markets for almonds have resulted in acreage being pulled, causing demand for bees to subside. All the same, as beekeepers survey damage in hives, losses could be high enough to stabilize pollination fees. We are holding prices the same as last year," he said. "Our costs have gone up, and colony losses remain high. We have to recover the lost income or go out of business. It costs a lot to provide bees for pollination when you only have half of your outfit with bees in the boxes." The outlook on pollination fees should get clearer the closer the industry gets to mid-February when hives are placed in almond orchards. "It's still a big question, what with the low price for nuts," a beekeeper said. "We'll know a month from now. Up till then, it's anyone's guess."

FLORIDA: Temperatures were slightly cooler and precipitation was slightly above normal for the month in most areas. Bee health was considered to be fairly good. Wildflowers were the main source of food for the bees and was primarily Spanish Needle. There was also some residual honey left in the hives consisting mostly of Goldenrod, aster, Spanish Needle and a little Brazilian Pepper. Supplemental feeding was necessary in much of north Florida and a few other areas scattered around the state. Many beekeepers were treating for mites with some also splitting hives in anticipation of the California almond pollination season early next year. Most beekeepers not planning on the January trip to California were expected to split hives in January. There was essentially no honey produced during the month for commercial sale but small amounts of wildflower honey were available for the hive. Stored supplies of honey at the end of the month were fairly light and consisted primarily of wildflower honey from the sources listed earlier and produced in November.

GEORGIA: Supplies of honey are running low and some beekeepers are having to turn down new customers as the crop from last was short on volume. Currently they are waiting for the weather to get warmer from the freezing temperatures so they can get back into the hives and check on the bees. Some of the beekeepers will not be sending hives out to California for the Almond crop in February in order to rebuild their numbers while others will be sending some out around February 15th of this year. The bees are reported to be in good condition and shape with the cold conditions at this time.

Honey prices reported are below.

Wildflower: \$270 for a 5-gallon bucket with some as low as \$3.00-3.50 per pound. \$4.50 per pound wholesale and \$9.00 per pound retail

Tupelo: \$6.00-7.00 per pound in buckets

Sourwood: \$7.00 per pound in buckets

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of December temperatures were normal in Idaho. Precipitation in Idaho was normal. Utah had temperatures that were normal and precipitation that was a little below normal. Colorado had normal temperatures across the whole state, Precipitation for Colorado was normal for December.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in December Idaho had no drought to an area of moderate drought in Northern Idaho. Utah is currently under no drought to abnormally dry conditions in Southeast Utah. Colorado had normal soil moisture to severe drought in Southwestern Colorado.

Prices for the month of December were between \$2.85 and \$3.20 per pound with a mostly price of \$3.00 for Idaho, Colorado prices are too few producers reporting to determine a market. Prices for locally sourced honey in Utah are \$2.80-\$3.30 per pound with mostly \$3.00 to \$3.30.

ILLINOIS: The weather for December has been mild overall with warm temperatures, with very little snow and quite a bit of rain. The bees are ready for winter. Beekeepers are going to meetings, checking and repairing equipment and preparing to order packages in the new year from southern package producers. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather for December has been very mild with a small amount of snow and rainfall. Some Beekeepers report their bees in good condition. Beekeepers stopped supplemental feeding of their bees. Beekeepers are going to meetings and checking and repairing equipment. Demand for honey is good and demand exceeded supply at the retail level and demand was fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: Kentucky beekeepers had a relatively mild December to finish 2023. At the beginning of the year, there were temperatures in the 30s, which is not abnormal. However, as the holidays approached, some days reached as high as 70F. Beekeepers checked their hives, commenced feeding some hives that had become low, and/or treated their hives for varroa mites. Beekeepers were also preparing for the upcoming year, either by attending national conferences or upgrading facilities. Many associations planned educational events and booked speakers.

LOUISIANA: During the month of December temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, most of the state continues to be experiencing extreme drought with a line of exceptional drought running from the Northeast corner to the Southwest corner. There was another area of exceptional drought in the Southeast corner. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

MICHIGAN: No report issued.

MINNESOTA: During the month of December temperatures were normal across the whole state. Precipitation for December was above normal for the North end of the state, the South end of the state saw a little above average precipitation.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in December the whole state had abnormally dry to moderate dry soil moisture. Prices per pound in Minnesota were \$2.80-\$3.00 with mostly price of \$2.80-\$3.00 for locally sourced honey for the month of December.

MISSISSIPPI: Some beekeepers are sold out as volume was low. Drought conditions along with mites affected overall volume throughout the state and the late freeze last March shows some with only a 40 percent crop in total pounds available for sales. Higher prices reflect the lower volume with Wholesale at \$12.00-13.00 per quart and retail at \$19.00-20.00 per quart.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: Drier, warmer weather persists in most of the state, with the central/western counties from Monroe south to Stueben in moderate drought. Many beekeepers are finishing up oxalic treatments for varroa mites. Warmer temperatures enable increased activity of hives which will require more monitoring for consumption of winter feed. Reports of about 20% of beekeepers have already experienced significant fall colony loss (>15%). Ordering of Spring replacement bee packages and nucs underway. Holiday honey sales/demand very strong.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: Winter has generally been mild. Hives are in their overwinter locations. Water supplies are mostly going. Improved from some of the droughts in recent years. Temperatures have generally warmer than normal. For those bees in the West, temperatures have been slightly warmer and the weather generally drier most of the month. More rain is forecasted for January to aid the upcoming crop.

OHIO: Ohio overall ended the year with a 3 inch rain fall deficit. The last 3 weeks of pollinator bloom was a failure. Because of the bloom failure honeybees went into fall with a deficit of pollen (protein) to feed the 2024 season larvae. The honeybee queens will start laying a few eggs, within 4 days larvae must be fed.

Many Ohio honeybee colonies tried to replace their queens in August and September with many failures. Varroa mite populations in the commercial colonies that Hobby/backyard beekeepers own are failing because of misunderstanding of how to treat varroa. The beekeepers with Ohio Local adapted honeybees (Feral managed) are seeing very low mite populations going into 2024, the colonies are healthy.

Cool wet weather continued throughout December with several unseasonably warm days, including Christmas Day, when it was 62 F in Mansfield (Northern) and Columbus, Ohio as well as December 24 in Cincinnati. While some snow fell a week before Christmas, it was less than an inch. Moderate temperatures with overcast skies kept honeybees active most of the month. Most beekeepers have been feeding sugar products to help supplement the bees' energy needs. Of course, as the bees are active, so are the varroa mites which will continue to reproduce on the minimal number of broods being produced.

Honey prices remain stable, wholesale \$5.50 - \$6.00 per pound, retail \$9.00 - \$11.00 per pound.

OKLAHOMA: During the month of December temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was about normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Oklahoma had mostly normal soil moisture across the North and Central parts of the state.

Abnormally dry to moderate drought scattered across the southern part of the state. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: December was a quiet month in Tennessee, nothing blooming so no nectar or pollen sources. Beekeepers are running out of local honey form the past year. There have been a few reports of absconding colonies during cold periods when the bees should not have been flying. Beekeepers are finding colonies with plenty of stored honey but no bees or brood and no dead bees inside the colony. Dead bees are being found 10 to 30 yards in front of the colonies in large numbers, it appears they are flying out of the colonies when the temperature is below freezing and unable to return.

TEXAS: During the month of December temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation during December was slightly below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, much of the state has normal soil moisture with areas of moderate drought scattered throughout. There is still an area West of San Antonio of extreme drought. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: A little snow cover early in the month, was followed by some warmer weather as well as some light rain. Some snow fell in the mountains, but early cool weather was accompanied by rain across the state. Rain lessened later in the month although some snow in received in higher elevations in the Cascades. By the end of December the snow pack was lower than normal.

WISCONSIN: The weather has been good for December with temperatures above the seasonal average and with a normal amount of rain and snow. Beekeepers have prepared for the winter. Beekeepers have finished feeding their bees. Most beekeepers report that their bees are in good condition, some report a few dead hives. Beekeepers are going to meetings, checking and repairing their equipment and preparing for the spring. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
