North American Flour Milling Products 2024 Summary

May 2025

Combined United States and Canadian All Wheat Ground for Flour Up 1 Percent From 2023

This publication is a result of a joint effort by Statistics Canada and USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service to release the flour milling production information for both countries within one publication. United States flour milling production numbers for 2024 were previously released on May 1, 2025. Canadian flour milling production numbers were released on April 30, 2025.

Combined United States and Canadian all wheat ground for flour was 1.04 billion bushels in 2024, up 1 percent from 2023. Flour production totaled 480 million hundredweight compared to 476 million hundredweight in 2023.

Combined United States and Canadian durum wheat ground for flour and semolina was 73.4 million bushels in 2024, up less than 1 percent from 2023. Durum flour production totaled 35.3 million hundredweight, up 2 percent from 2023.
