Estimates of acreage, yield and production of soybeans harvested for beans, by counties in 19 producing States are herewith assembled for the crop years 1949, 1950 and preliminary 1951. These estimates are a breakdown of the latest official State estimates and were prepared by the Agricultural Statisticians in the respective States. Although soybean production is estimated in 29 States, the 19 States for which county estimates are shown account for 98 percent of the U. S. total production.
