Compared to last week, dairy steers have no comparison. Trade and demand moderate. Supply consisted of dairy steers weighing 325 lbs for June and July Delivery, along with a load of feeder heifers weighing 700 for Current Delivery. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (93.6% Dairy Steers, 6.4% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 6%. Unless otherwise stated, prices fob shipping point with 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent with 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weight. Delivered prices include freight, commissions and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from AZ, CA.
