Heifers Added

Compared to last week, feeders not well tested. Trade slow, demand light. Supply consisted of dairy steers weighing 275 lbs and feeder heifers weighing 725-850 lbs for Current Delivery. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (48% Dairy Steers, 52% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 52%. Unless otherwise stated, prices fob shipping point with 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent with 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weight. Delivered prices include freight, commissions and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from CA, NV.
