Compared to last week: No recent test for a market trend. Many diary steers traded for next spring and these sold to good demand. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (6.2% Steers, 93.8% Dairy Steers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 5%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3% shrink or equivalent, with a 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weight. Delivered prices include freight, commission and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from AZ, CA, ID, NM, TX.
