Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending December 31, 1996, amounted to 849,786 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of December was 563,872 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 11,245,913 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 2,571,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 796,600 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(96)-12", dated January 24, 1997.

Estimates are for All Cotton ginned prior to February 1, 1997.
