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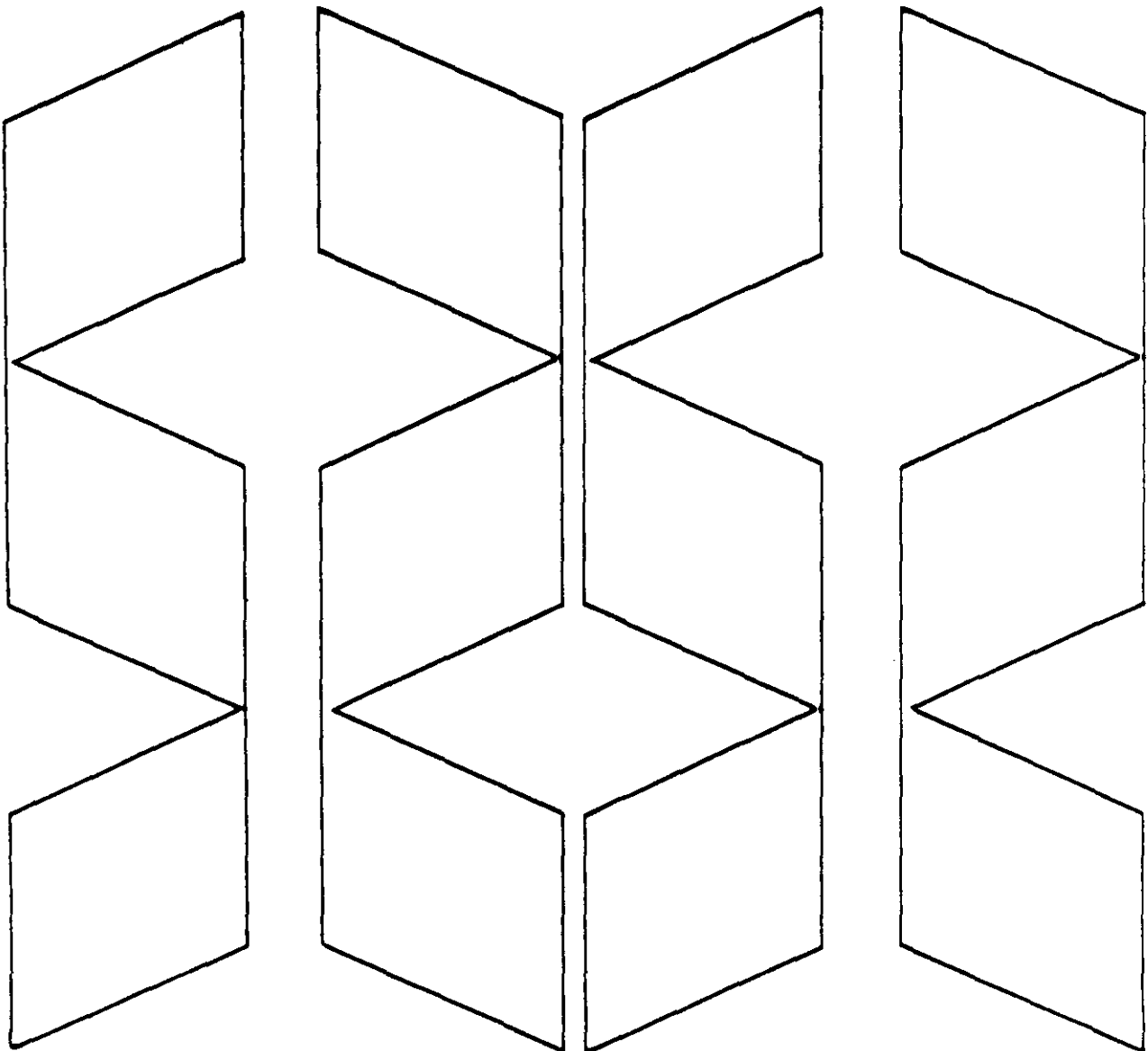
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Livestock Slaughter

1990 Summary



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SLAUGHTER AND RED MEAT PRODUCTION 1990

RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during 1990 totaled 38.8 billion pounds, down 2 percent from 1989. Production included beef, veal, pork, and lamb and mutton slaughter in commercial plants and on farms.

BEEF PRODUCTION was 22.7 billion pounds, down 2 percent from 1989. **VEAL PRODUCTION** was 327 million pounds, down 8 percent from 1989. **PORK PRODUCTION** was 15.4 billion pounds, down 3 percent from 1989. **LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION** totaled 362 million pounds, up 4 percent from 1989.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1990 totaled 33.2 million head, down 2 percent from 1989, with federal inspection comprising 97.4 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 1.79 million head, was down 18 percent from the previous year with 97.3 percent under federal inspection. Hog kill totaled 85.1 million head, down 4 percent from 1989 with federal inspection comprising 97.4 percent. Commercial sheep and lamb slaughter at 5.65 million head, was up 3 percent from 1989 with federal inspection comprising 96.7 percent.

Average live weight of cattle slaughtered commercially in 1990 was 1,136 pounds, up 2 pounds from 1989. The calf average live weight was 284 pounds for 1990, an increase of 19 pounds from the previous year. Average live weight for hogs increased 1 pound to 249. Sheep and lambs averaged 125 pounds live weight, up 1 pound from 1989.
