

LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, BY STATES, 1954
REVISED MONTHLY ESTIMATES

May 1955

Revised monthly estimates of livestock slaughtered in commercial plants during 1954, by States and for the United States, are presented in this report. The estimates include meat and lard production for the United States and the number, average live weight per head, and total live weight of each species of livestock slaughtered, by States. Slaughter in Federally inspected plants and in other wholesale and retail plants are included, but farm slaughter is excluded.

The estimates differ slightly from the monthly estimates issued currently in 1954. Revisions are based on a further review of current information and additional data received from municipal and State inspection services in some States.

This report is made possible through the cooperative efforts of the Agricultural Research Service and the Agricultural Marketing Service.
