- REVISED MONTHLY ESTIMATES -

This report presents, by States and for the United States, a record of the total number and live weight of animals slaughtered in commercial slaughtering plants during 1951, and a record of commercial meat production in the United States for the year. Revised estimates for hog slaughter for 1949 and 1950 are also presented in this report. These revisions are reflected in the production of pork, lard and total meat. No revisions have been made for cattle, calves, sheep and lambs for 1949 and 1950. The estimates include slaughter in federally inspected plants and in other wholesale and retail plants, but exclude farm slaughter.

The series presented in this report take into account revisions of the estimates of other wholesale and retail slaughter in some States. These revisions resulted from a review of information collected currently on slaughter, and of data obtained through municipal and State inspection services.

This report is made possible through the cooperative efforts of the three agencies in the Department of Agriculture--the Bureau of Animal Industry, the Livestock Branch of the Production and Marketing Administration, and the Bureau of Agricultural Economics.
