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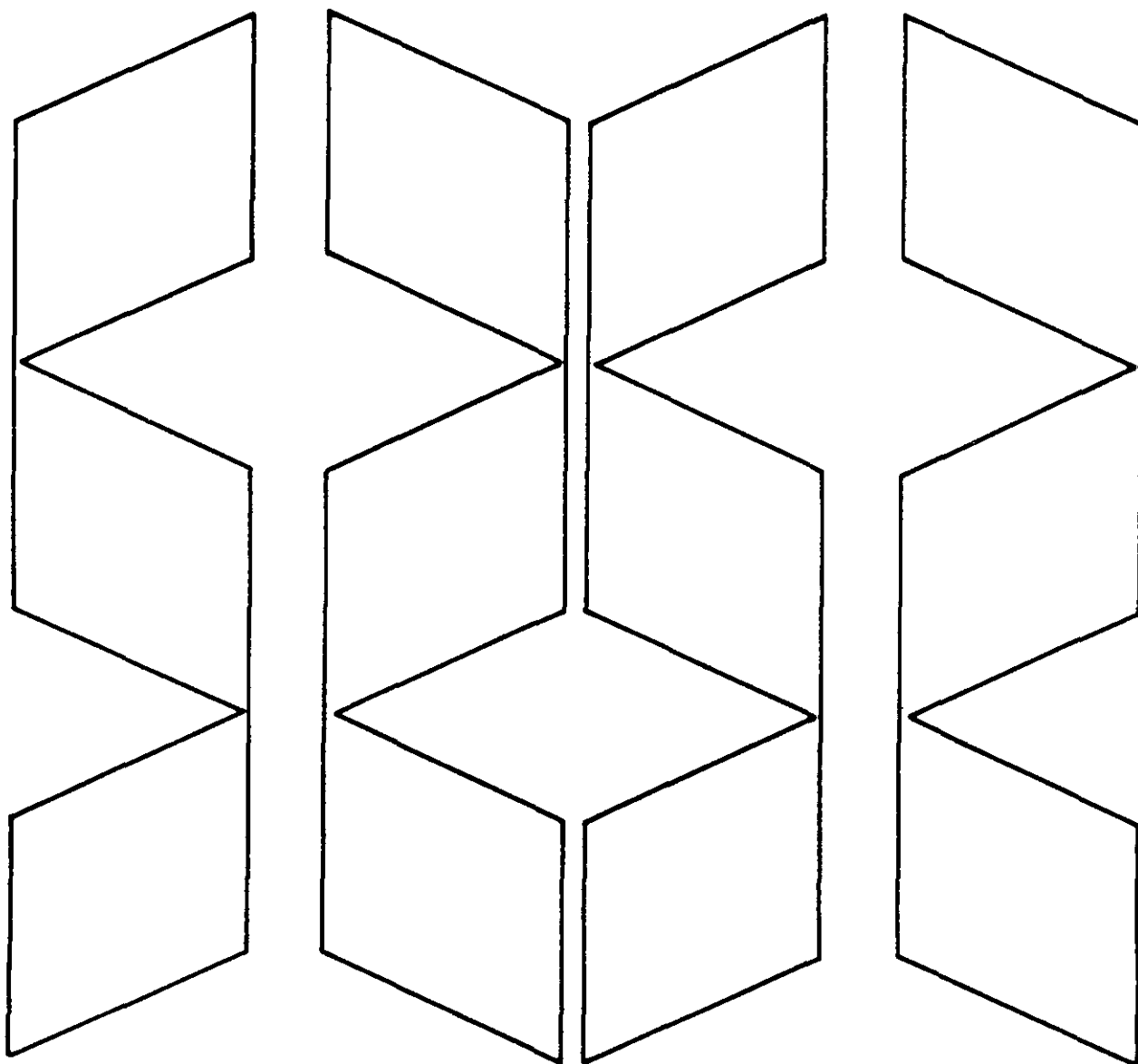

1986 Summary

TOTAL SLAUGHTER, MEAT AND LARD PRODUCTION 1986

RED MEAT Production for the United States during 1986 totaled 39.3 billion pounds (17.8 million metric tons), down slightly from 1985. Production included beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughter in commercial establishments and on farms.

BEEF PRODUCTION was 24.4 billion pounds (11.1 million metric tons), 3 percent above 1985. VEAL PRODUCTION was 524 million pounds (238 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent from 1985. PORK PRODUCTION was 14.1 billion pounds (6.38 million metric tons), down 5 percent from 1985. LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION totaled 337 million pounds (153 thousand metric tons), a decreased of 6 percent from 1985. LARD PRODUCTION, 874 million pounds (396 thousand metric tons), was down 6 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1986 totaled 37.3 million head, up 3 percent from 1985, with federal inspection comprising 96.3 percent of the 1986 total. Calf slaughter, at 3.41 million head, was up 1 percent from the previous year with 93.8 percent under federal inspection. Hog kill totaled 79.6 million head, down 6 percent from 1985, with federal inspection comprising 97.1 percent. Commercial sheep and lamb slaughter decreased 9 percent from 1985 to 5.64 million head of which 97.0 percent was in Federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of cattle slaughtered commercially in 1986 was 1100 pounds, up 2 pounds from 1985. The calf average live weight was 251 pounds for 1986, an increase of 3 pounds from the previous year. Average live weight for hogs increased 1 pound to 246. Sheep and lambs averaged 117 pounds live weight, up 3 pounds from 1985.
