LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, BY STATES, 1952
REVISED MONTHLY ESTIMATES

May 1953

This report presents, by States and for the United States, revised monthly estimates of livestock slaughtered in commercial plants during 1952. This report includes monthly estimates of meat and lard production for the United States and monthly estimates by States of the number of head, average live weight per head, and total live weight of each species of livestock slaughtered. These estimates include slaughter in Federally inspected plants and in other wholesale and retail plants, but exclude farm slaughter.

The estimates in this report differ slightly from the current monthly reports issued in 1952. These revisions were based on a further review of current information and from additional data received from municipal and State inspection services in some States.

This report is made possible through the cooperative efforts of three agencies in the Department of Agriculture--the Bureau of Animal Industry, the Livestock Branch of the Production and Marketing Administration, and the Bureau of Agricultural Economics.
