LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, BY STATES
NOVEMBER 1947

Commercial meat production in the United States during November 1947 was 5 percent less than in November 1946 but for the first 11 months of 1947 was 3 percent larger than the same period of the previous year, the Bureau of Agricultural Economics reports. The estimated meat production includes beef, veal, lamb and mutton, and pork slaughter in Federally inspected and other wholesale and retail plants but excludes farm slaughter.

Compared with a year earlier, November 1947 production of pork was down 8 percent while beef was down 4 percent and lamb and mutton 7 percent. However, veal production was up 2 percent.

For the first 11 months of 1947, meat production totaled 19.1 billion pounds, 3 percent more than the 18.5 billion pounds in the same period of 1946. Beef and veal each was up 13 percent while pork was down 6 percent and lamb and mutton down 19 percent.

The number of cattle slaughtered in November was 1,836,600, approximately 90 thousand less than a year earlier. However, average live weight per head was 12 pounds heavier, resulting in a net decrease of only 3 percent in total live weight and 4 percent in dressed weight. November calf slaughter of 1,172,300 head was up 7 percent from the 1,093,600 slaughtered in November 1946. Average live weight was 9 pounds or 4 percent less, leaving a net increase of only 3 percent in total live weight and 2 percent in veal production. Lamb and mutton production was down 7 percent, the result of a 4-percent decrease in number slaughtered and a 2-pound lighter average weight per head. The number of hogs slaughtered was 6,747,000 head, a decrease of nearly 7 percent from the 7,218,000 in November 1946. Average live weight per head also was less than a year earlier -- 232 pounds compared with 239 pounds. This resulted in a decrease of 9 percent in total live weight of hog slaughter. A slightly smaller proportion of the carcass went into lard, resulting in a net decrease of 8 percent in pork production (excluding lard) and a 12-percent decrease in lard rendered as compared with November 1946.

During the first 11 months of 1947, the number of cattle slaughtered was 16 percent larger than during the same period in 1946. However, average live weight per head was 13 pounds less resulting in a 14-percent increase in total live weight. Beef production was 9,253 million pounds, an increase of 13 percent or 1,095 million pounds over the first 11 months of 1946. Veal production during the January-November period in 1947 was also 13 percent larger than a year earlier, having increased 160 million pounds to a total of 1,375 million. This resulted from a 14-percent increase in number of head slaughtered which more than offset a one-pound drop in average live weight. Mutton and lamb production for the first 11 months of 1947 was 19 percent less than in 1946. January-November pork production (excluding lard) in 1947 was 7 3/4 billion pounds, a decrease of 6 percent from the same period in 1946. Lard production, however, was 19 percent larger for the 11-month period, 1,768 million pounds in 1947 against 1,490 million in 1946, reflecting the larger proportion of carcass weight that went into lard. The proportion of hogs raised in the Corn Belt and slaughtered in that area continued above a year earlier.

The estimated number of cattle slaughtered in November 1947 as compared with a year earlier was down in nearly all States. Increases were confined mostly to the West North Central States and South Atlantic States. For the first 11 months in 1947, cattle slaughter was greater than in 1946 in most of the Central States and the important slaughtering States of the West. Compared with 1946, the November calf slaughter was larger in most of the Atlantic and North Central States and in California. For the 11 months, larger calf slaughter occurred in most of the same States as well as in the major slaughtering States of the West. Some increases over 1946 occurred in sheep and lamb slaughter in November. However, for the 11 months it was less in nearly all States. Hog slaughter in November (and for the January-November period) was less than a year earlier in most States. Increases were confined mainly to the West North Central States.

This report is made possible through the cooperative efforts of three agencies in the Department of Agriculture which collect the primary data -- the Bureau of Animal Industry, the Livestock Branch of the Production and Marketing Administration, and the Bureau of Agricultural Economics. DECEMBER 1947

Commercial meat production in the United States during December 1947 was 5 percent more than in December 1946, the Bureau of Agricultural Economics reports. The total for the year 1947 was 3 percent more than in 1946. The estimated meat production includes beef, veal, lamb and mutton, and pork slaughter in Federally inspected and other wholesale and retail plants. It excludes farm slaughter.

Compared with a year earlier, December 1947 production of pork was up 11 percent, veal was up 4 percent, and lamb and mutton 5 percent. However, beef production was down 2 percent.

For the year of 1947, meat production totaled 21.2 billion pounds, 3 percent more than the 20.5 billion in 1946. Beef and veal production were each 12 percent larger while production of pork was 5 percent less and lamb and mutton 18 percent less.

Cattle slaughtered during December 1947 totaled 1,846,300 head, 16 thousand less than a year earlier. Average live weight per head was 1 pound heavier, resulting in a net decrease of 1 percent in total live weight slaughtered and 2 percent in beef production. The number of calves slaughtered was 9 percent more than in December 1946. However, this was partly offset by a 6-pound lighter average live weight per head, making veal production only 4 percent more than a year earlier. Total live weight of hogs slaughtered in December 1947 was nearly 12 percent more than a year earlier, the result of a 13 percent increase in number slaughtered although average live weight per head was 2 pounds less. Pork production (excluding lard) was 11 percent larger than last year and lard rendered decreased 12 percent. A slightly larger proportion of the carcass weight went into lard than in December 1946.

During the year of 1947, the number of cattle and calves slaughtered was each 14 percent more than in 1946. For each, the average live weight was slightly less, resulting in a 12-percent increase in both beef and veal production. The number and total live weight of hogs slaughtered in 1947 was 1 percent less than in 1946. A much larger proportion of carcass weight went into lard production in 1947, resulting in a 5-percent decrease in pork (excluding lard) and an 18-percent increase in lard production.

Compared with a year earlier, December slaughter of cattle was larger in nearly all States east of the Plains States and smaller in practically all of the Plains and Western States. For the year 1947, cattle slaughter was greater than in 1946 in most of the Central States and the major slaughtering States of the West but was smaller in most of the Mountain and Atlantic States. As compared with a year earlier, calf slaughter was larger, both in December and for the year, in most of the Atlantic and North Central States and important slaughtering States of the West. Increased hog slaughter for the year was confined largely to the North Central States. However, for the month of December substantial increases occurred also in the Southeastern and Pacific Coast States. Sheep and lamb slaughter was less than 1946 in nearly all States.

This report is made possible through the cooperative efforts of three agencies in the Department of Agriculture which collect the primary data -- the Bureau of Animal Industry, the Livestock Branch of the Production and Marketing Administration, and the Bureau of Agricultural Economics. For a description of the data and the responsibilities of the agencies involved, see the report, "Livestock Slaughter, by States and by Months, 1946," published August 1947 by the Bureau of Agricultural Economics.

The estimates include slaughter in Federally inspected plants and in other wholesale and retail plants, but excludes farm slaughter.

The series presented in this report take into account revisions of the estimates of other wholesale and retail slaughter in some States. These revisions resulted from a review of information collected currently on slaughter, and of data obtained through municipal and State inspection services.
