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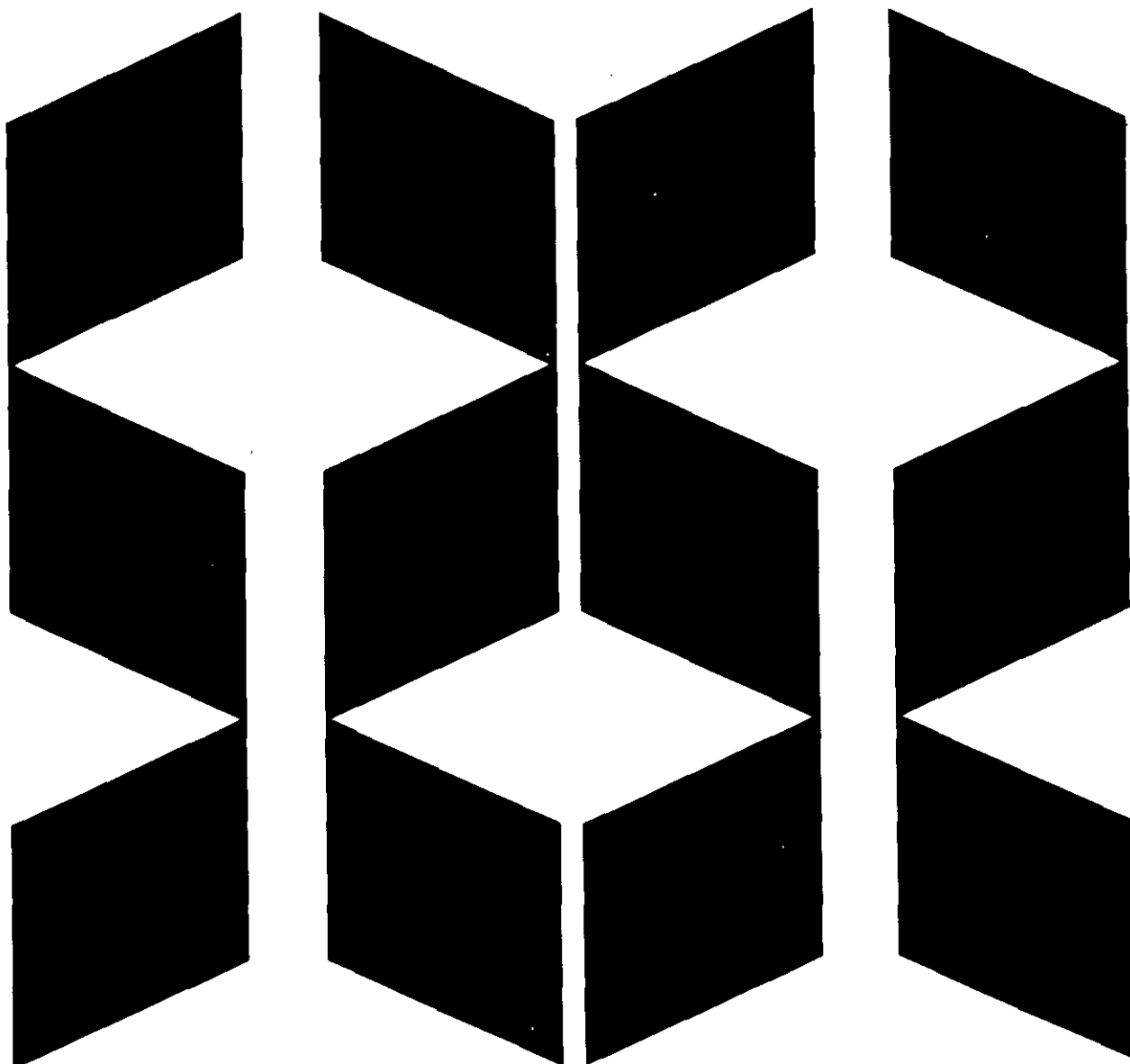

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TOTAL SLAUGHTER, MEAT AND LARD PRODUCTION 1983

Red meat production for the United States during 1983 totaled 39.3 billion pounds (17.8 million metric tons), up 5 percent from 1982. Production included beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughtered in commercial establishments and on farms.

BEEF PRODUCTION was 23.2 billion pounds (10.5 million metric tons), 3 percent above 1982. VEAL PRODUCTION increased 1 percent for a total of 454 million pounds (206 thousand metric tons) in 1983. PORK PRODUCTION increased 7 percent to 15.2 billion pounds (6.90 million metric tons). LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION totaled 376 million pounds (171 thousand metric tons), an increase of 3 percent from 1982. Lard production, at 978 million pounds (444 thousand metric tons), was up 6 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1983 totaled 36.6 million head, up 2 percent from 1982, with Federal inspection comprising 95.0 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 3.08 million head was up 2 percent from the previous year with 90.9 percent under Federal inspection. Hog kill totaled 87.6 million head, up 7 percent from last year, with Federal inspection comprising 96.8 percent. Commercial sheep and lamb slaughter increased 3 percent from 1982 to 6.62 million head of which 96.9 percent was in Federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of cattle slaughtered commercially in 1983 was 1071 pounds, up 7 pounds from 1982. For calves slaughtered in 1983, the average live weight was 237 pounds, up 1 pound from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs, at 243 pounds was unchanged from 1982. Sheep and lambs averaged 112 pounds live weight, up 1 pound from 1982.
