TOTAL SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION, 1981

Total red meat production for the United States in 1981, at 39.0 billion pounds (17.7 million metric tons), was virtually unchanged from 1980. Production included beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughtered in commercial establishments and on farms. BEEF production was 22.4 billion pounds (10.2 million metric tons), up 3 percent from 1980. There were 436 million pounds (198 thousand metric tons) of VEAL produced, 9 percent above the previous year. PORK production decreased 4 percent to 15.9 billion pounds (7.20 million metric tons), and LAMB AND MUTTON increased 6 percent to 338 million pounds (153 thousand metric tons). Lard production, at 1.17 billion pounds (529 thousand metric tons), was down 4 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1981 totaled 35.0 million head, up 3 percent from 1980, with federal inspection accounting for 93.9 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 2.80 million head, was up 8 percent from last year and 88.6 percent was under federal inspection. Hog slaughter, with 95.9 percent slaughtered in federally inspected establishments, decreased 5 percent to 91.6 million head. Commercial sheep and lamb kill increased 8 percent from 1980 to 6.01 million head, of which 96.4 percent was in federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of commercial cattle slaughtered in 1981 was 1075 pounds, up 3 pounds from 1980. For calves slaughtered in 1981, the average live weight was 250 pounds, a 5 pound increase from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs increased 1 pound to 243; and sheep and lambs averaged 110 pounds, down 2 pounds from 1980.
