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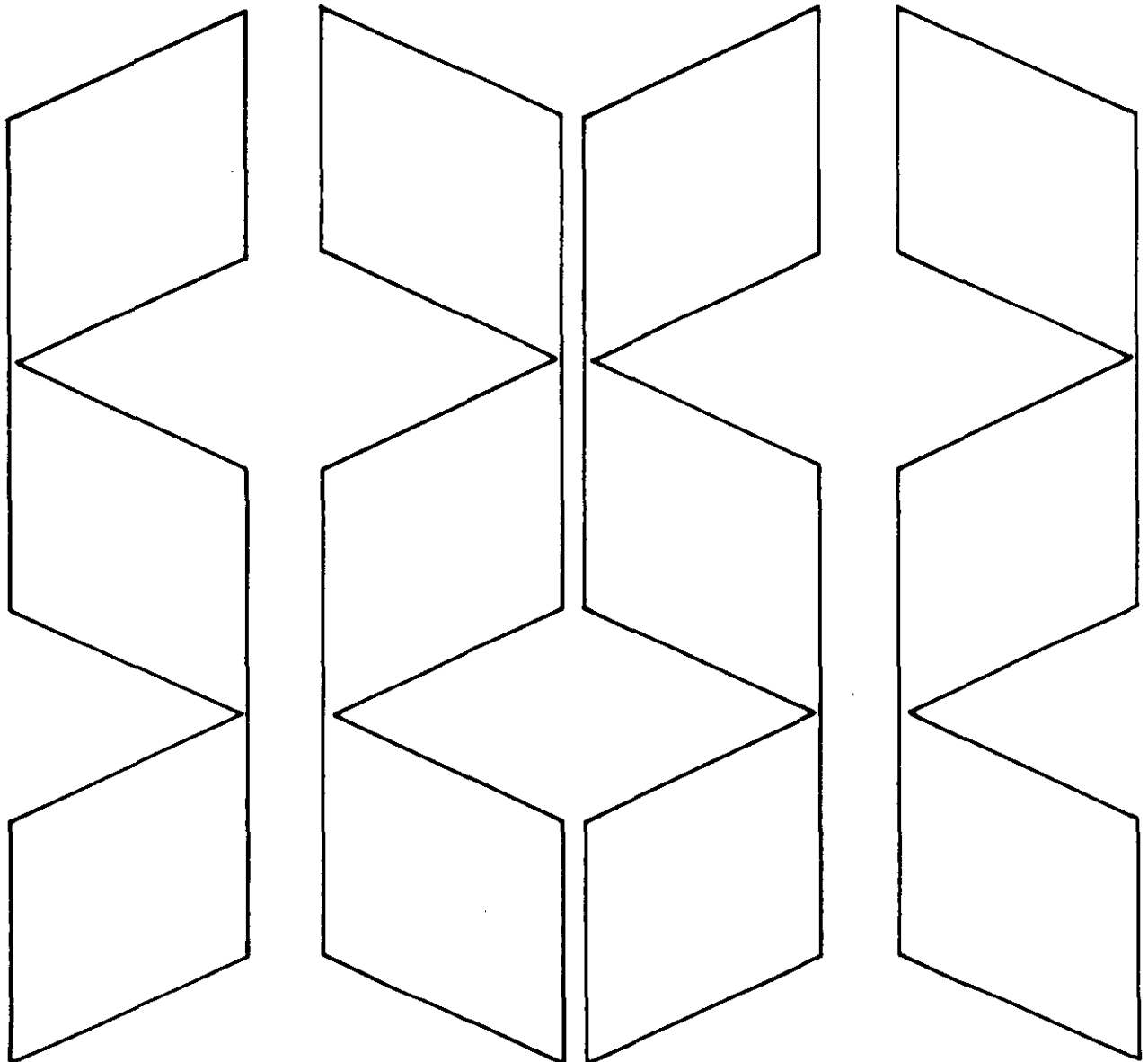

TOTAL SLAUGHTER, MEAT AND LARD PRODUCTION 1985

Red meat production for the United States during 1985 totaled 39.4 billion pounds (17.9 million metric tons), up slightly from 1984. Production included beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughter in commercial establishments and on farms.

BEEF PRODUCTION was 23.7 billion pounds (10.8 million metric tons), 1 percent above 1984. VEAL PRODUCTION increased 4 percent for a total of 514 million pounds (233 thousand metric tons) in 1985. PORK PRODUCTION was 14.8 billion pounds (6.72 million metric tons), virtually unchanged from 1984. LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION totaled 357 million pounds (162 thousand metric tons), a decrease of 6 percent from 1984. Lard production, 929 million pounds (421 thousand metric tons), was down 1 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1985 totaled 36.3 million head, down 3 percent from 1984, with Federal inspection comprising 95.8 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 3.39 million head, was up 3 percent from the previous year with 93.6 percent under Federal inspection. Hog kill totaled 84.5 million head, down 1 percent from last year, with Federal inspection comprising 97.0 percent. Commercial sheep and lamb slaughter decreased 9 percent from 1984 to 6.17 million head of which 96.9 percent was in Federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of cattle slaughtered commercially in 1985 was 1098 pounds, up 31 pounds from 1984. The calf average live weight was 248 pounds for 1985, an increase of 4 pounds from the previous year. Average live weight for hogs increased 2 pounds to 245. Sheep and lambs averaged 114 pounds live weight, up 3 pounds from 1984.
