TOTAL SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION, 1979

Total Red Meat Production for the United States in 1979 totaled 37.6 billion pounds, down 2 percent from the 38.6 billion pounds produced in 1978. Production included beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughtered in commercial establishments and on farms. Beef production was 21.4 billion pounds, down 12 percent from 1978. There were 434 million pounds of veal produced, 31 percent below the previous year. Pork production increased 15 percent to 15.5 billion pounds, while lamb and mutton declined 5 percent to 293 million pounds. Lard production, at 1.16 billion pounds, was up 15 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1979 totaled 33.7 million head, down 15 percent from 1978, with federal inspection accounting for 93.5 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 2.82 million head, was down 32 percent from last year with 88.5 percent under federal inspection. Hog slaughter increased 15 percent to 89.1 million head with 95.9 percent slaughtered in federally inspected establishments. Commercial sheep and lamb kill declined 7 percent from 1978 to 5.02 million head, of which 96.3 percent was in federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of commercial cattle slaughtered in 1979 was 1060 pounds, up 24 pounds from 1978. For calves slaughtered in 1979, the average live weight was 244, a 1 pound increase from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs, at 242, was up 2 pounds, and sheep and lambs averaged 114, up 2 pounds.
