LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION, 1978

Total Red Meat Production for the United States in 1978 totaled 38.6 billion pounds, down 3 percent from the 39.7 billion pounds produced in 1977. Production includes beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughtered in commercial establishments and on-farms. Beef production was 24.2 billion pounds, down 4 percent from 1977. There were 632 million pounds of veal produced, 24 percent below the previous year. Pork production increased 1 percent to 13.4 billion pounds, while lamb and mutton declined 12 percent to 309 million pounds. Lard production, at 1.01 billion pounds, was down 3 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1978 totaled 39.6 million head, down 6 percent from 1977, with federal inspection accounting for 93.4 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 4.17 million head, was down 24 percent from last year with 86.8 percent under federal inspection. Hog slaughter was virtually the same as last year at 77.3 million head with 95.9 percent of the hogs slaughtered in federally inspected establishments. Commercial sheep and lamb kill declined 16 percent from 1977 to 5.37 million head, of which 96.3 percent was in federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of commercial cattle slaughtered in 1978 was 1036 pounds, up 12 pounds from 1977. For calves slaughtered in 1978, the average live weight was 243, down 6 pounds from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs, at 240 pounds, was up 3 pounds, and sheep and lambs averaged 112, up 4 pounds.
