Compared to last week: Trade activity moderate and good. Small squares of horse quality hay sold steady to 50 cents higher. Large squares of feedlot/dairy quality hay sold mostly steady. According to the USDA NASS Colorado Crop Progress report for week ending August 8, 2021, the 2nd cutting of alfalfa is 74 percent harvested, 3rd cutting 12 percent harvested with stored feed supplies rated 7 percent very short, 23 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 14 percent surplus. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, the Mountains and Northwest Colorado region is suffering from the heaviest drought classification (D3 and D4) while the Southwest and San Luis Valley Colorado regions have seen positive drought classification improvements over the past few weeks. Central and Southeast Colorado have received enough rain to keep them out of drought classifications. Logan, Washington, Yuma, Sedgwick and Phillips counties drought conditions have worsened this week to an Abnormally Dry (D1) drought classification. The next available report will be Thursday, August 19, 2021.
