Compared to last week: Trade activity moderate on very good demand for horse hay markets with prices unchanged on comparable trades. Trade activity moderate on good demand for feedlot and dairy hay as prices slowly continue to increase to match higher RFV values. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor's High Plains Summary for August 23, 2022, warm, dry conditions continued across the region. Moderate drought (D1) expanded in western South Dakota and northeast Wyoming where rainfall deficits of near 3 inches over the last 90 days dried out soils, lowered streamflow, and stressed vegetation. Additional analysis across the High Plains next week is likely to result in increasing drought severity across parts of the region due to persistent dry weather. According to the NASS Colorado Crop Progress Report for the week ending August 21, 2022, 2nd cutting alfalfa harvested is 95 percent, and 3rd cutting alfalfa is 40 percent. Stored feed supplies were rated 22 percent very short, 25 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. The next available report will be Thursday, September 1, 2022.
