Compared to the last report: Trade activity light on good demand for horse hay markets. Trade inactive on dairy and feedlot markets. All markets sold steady this period. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor's High Plains Summary for January 11, 2022, substantial precipitation (over 0.5 inch) was generally restricted to higher-elevation areas in Wyoming and Colorado. Heavy precipitation has been common across the higher elevations of central and northern Colorado in the past couple of months. Some of these mountains received several inches more than normal precipitation in the last 90 days, resulting in abundant snowpack that prompted drought improvement through this region. The next available report will be Thursday, January 20, 2022.
