DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

The market on frozen 8-16 lb. hens and 16-24 lb. toms is steady to weak. The undertone for the November fresh market on hens and consumer sized toms is steady to weak. Frozen whole turkey inquiry is light to moderate. Offerings are mostly moderate. Frozen domestic Grade A basted equivalent processor offering prices on a national basis for 8-16 lb. hens are 121.00-149.00 FOB and 16-24 lb. toms 121.00-149.00 cents FOB for current shipments. No domestic trading reported.

The fresh tom breast meat market is steady to weak. Demand for fresh is moderate, while light to moderate for frozen. Offerings are at least moderate for both. The destrapped tenderloin and white trims markets are steady to weak. Demand is light for the moderate to moderately heavy offerings. Further processed demand is moderate to fairly good. The tom bulk parts market is steady to weak. Demand is light to moderate. Offerings are moderate to instances heavy. The thigh meat and bone-in thigh markets are steady to weak. Demand is light to moderate. Offerings are mixed, generally moderate. The mechanically separated turkey market is steady with a steady to weak undertone. Demand is light. Offerings are light to moderate. Trading is slow to moderate.

EXPORT MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

Trading is slow to moderate. The market is steady with undertones ranging steady to weak. Demand is light to moderate. Offerings are mixed, generally moderate.
