DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

The market on frozen 8-16 lb. hens and 16-24 lb. toms is steady to weak with trading reported at lower trending prices on 2024 production. Demand light. Offerings moderate to instances burdensome. Frozen domestic 2024 production Grade A basted equivalent processor offering prices on a national basis for Grade A 8-16 lb. hens are 84.00-103.00 FOB and 16-24 lb. toms 86.00-105.00 cents FOB for current shipments. Trading moderate for current deliveries. Frozen 2024 production basted equivalent 8-16 lb. hens 84 cents FOB for current shipments.

The market on fresh tom breast meat is steady to sometimes weak, frozen steady with steady to weak undertones. Demand light to instances moderate. Offerings moderate to moderately heavy. The fresh destrapped tenderloin market is steady while frozen is steady with mixed undertones. The white trim markets are steady with steady to barely steady undertones. Demand light to instances moderate with more activity noted on frozen destrapped tenderloins. Destrapped tenderloin and white trims offerings are uneven ranging light to moderately heavy with breast trim and destrapped tenderloins starting to move into a better balance. Further processed demand slow to moderate. The market on 4-8 lb. breasts is steady to weak. Institutional sized rib breasts are steady to barely steady. Demand light. Offerings light to moderate. The market on tom drums and wings is steady to firm, and necks steady to instances weak. Tom 2-joint wing demand moderate to good, balance of tom bulk parts light to instances good mostly moderate. Offerings of tom 2-joint wings short to very light, balance light to moderate with necks instances moderately heavy. The thigh meat and bone-in thigh markets are steady to firm. Demand moderate to good. Offerings very light to light. The fresh mechanically separated turkey market is steady. Demand and fresh offerings light to moderate. Frozen offerings light. Trading slow to moderate. Processors working shortened holiday schedules.

EXPORT MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

Trading slow. The market on tom necks is steady to barely steady, balance of parts and meat items steady to instances firm. Demand mixed, mostly moderate with some export destinations working shortened holiday processing schedules. Offerings very light to light.
