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INTRODUCTION

This is the fifth bulletin on cold-storage warehouse space, and stocks of fruits, dairy products, eggs, dressed poultry, meats, lard, and fish carried in cold-storage warehouses, in the United States.

The tables showing refrigerated warehouse space are compiled from the survey made as of October 1, 1929. The establishments included in this survey were those artificially cooled to a temperature of 45° F., or below, in which food commodities were stored and held for 30 days or more and those in which meats and fish were frozen and cured. Since some commodities not reported as in cold storage are stored in space cooled to a temperature varying from 45° to 60°, all refrigerated space is shown in the tabulation in order to make a complete report on refrigerated space.

The results of the first space survey, published October 1, 1922, showed 1,315 concerns with 559,138,225 cubic feet of refrigerated warehouse space. Since that time there has been continual expansion, and the 1929 survey showed 1,400 concerns with 728,594,833 cubic feet, an increase of about 30 per cent in the seven years. The increase from the previous biennial survey of October 1, 1927, was 9 per cent, or 60,748,260 cubic feet.

The form of Statistical Bulletin No. 26, on cold-storage holdings, has been followed in this bulletin so the tables on refrigerated space

are comparable; the commodity tables are similar, except that in this publication they are brought up to December 1, 1929; the fish tables have been brought up to December 15, 1929.

Additional tables give holdings of cold-pack fruit and pears and apples packed in bushel baskets.

No changes have been made in the method of compiling and issuing the monthly cold-storage report, which continues to be released on or about the 12th of each month. Occasionally the expression is heard that an earlier release of this report should be made; but at the present time this is not feasible. Many factors enter into the assembling of the material that goes to make up the report. Considerable time is required for the careful editing and scrutinizing of the many schedules to insure correct reports. The form in which the returns are received in the office determines, to a large extent, the time required. Under present conditions the Bureau of Agricultural Economics does not feel justified in attempting to make an earlier release.

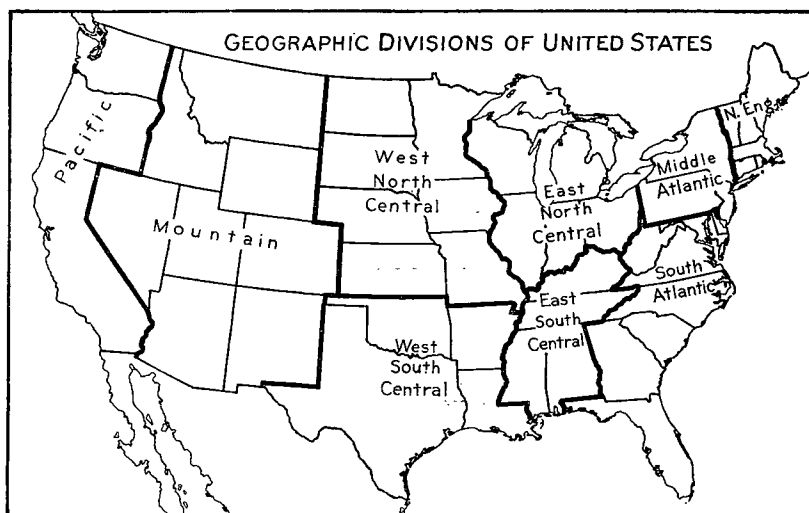


FIGURE 1.—The census geographic divisions as used in Table 1

For those who use the cold-storage figures as a guide in their businesses, accuracy rather than speed is the essential consideration, although it is desirable that the information be available as quickly as is consistent with accuracy. The information compiled daily and weekly, and representing respectively, 50 and 75 per cent of the total United States stocks of butter, American cheese, case eggs, and frozen poultry is a reliable basis for estimating in advance the total for any given month.

Current monthly figures of cold-storage holdings of all commodities except fish are disseminated over leased telegraph wires to the various branch offices of the Bureau of Agricultural Economics, are published in the printed monthly publication *Crops and Markets*, and are available in mimeograph summary form immediately after the release has been made. Details as to holdings of fish may be had, as soon as they are compiled, from the Bureau of Agricultural Economics, United

States Department of Agriculture, or from the Bureau of Fisheries, United States Department of Commerce.

An early release of the report on certain varieties of fish is made in mimeograph form, and later a full report is made in bulletin form by the Bureau of Fisheries.

The map (fig. 1) shows the grouping of States into geographic divisions. Table 1 shows the percentage holdings of the various commodities by geographic divisions, and is based on the year 1929.
