1982 ANNUAL SUMMARY

ACREAGE, YIELD, PRODUCTION, & VALUE

This report includes estimates for 9 principal fresh market vegetables. In previous years, estimates were available for 22 crops. Also, the number of processing vegetable crops estimated by the Statistical Reporting Service has been reduced from 10 to 4 crops. These reductions are part of a general modification of the crop and livestock estimating program to stay within the fiscal 1982 funding level. Estimates for the following fresh market crops have been discontinued: artichokes, asparagus, snap beans, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cantaloup, cucumbers, eggplant, escarole/endive, garlic, green peppers, watermelons and spinach. Estimates for the following processing vegetable crops have been discontinued: lima beans, beets, cabbage for kraut, cucumbers for pickles, spinach and asparagus. Crops being continued in the program are shown on the inside cover.

FRESH MARKET VEGETABLES ANNUAL SUMMARY 1982

Production of 9 principal fresh market vegetables and melons in 1982 is estimated at 203 million hundredweight (9.2 million metric tons), 5 percent more than in 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The total crop was harvested from 925 thousand acres (374 thousand hectares), 3 percent less than the area harvested in 1981.

The 9 principal vegetables and melons harvested during 1982 had a total value of 2.61 billion dollars, a fractional increase over the previous year.

The five leading States in production of fresh vegetables and melons during 1982 in order of total output were California, Florida, Arizona, Texas and New York. These States accounted for 76 percent of the harvested area, 78 percent of the production and 83 percent of the value of the 9 fresh market vegetables and melons estimated in the United States.

PROCESSING VEGETABLES UP 21 PERCENT

A total of 11.9 million tons (10.8 million metric tons) of processing vegetables were harvested in 1982 from 7 major vegetable crops produced for that purpose. This is a jump of 21 percent from last year and 17 percent above 1980.

Production for processing decreased only for snap beans, but increased on each of the other 6 crops. Processing tomatoes were up 28 percent. Cauliflower production increased 18 percent; sweet corn gained 16 percent; green peas were up 15 percent. Broccoli processing increased 12 percent, and carrots were up 10 percent.

Total value of processed production for the 7 vegetables is placed at 1.03 billion dollars, 22 percent above 1981 and 29 percent above 1980. Values increased over last year for all processing vegetable crops except snap beans.

The five leading States in order of total output of the 4 principal vegetables (snap beans, sweet corn, green peas and tomatoes) for processing are California, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Washington and Oregon. These 5 States accounted for 81 percent of the production, 74 percent of the harvested area, and 77 percent of the total value of these 4 crops in the United States.
