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ACREAGE HIGHLIGHTS

1980 CONTRACT AREA DOWN 14 PERCENT

The preliminary estimate of the 1980 contracted area of the Nation's major processing vegetables is set at 1.45 million acres (588 thousand hectares), according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is a decrease of 14 percent from the 1.68 million acres (682 thousand hectares) contracted during 1979. All eight major crops with estimated contract acreage shown in this report are showing decreases in acreage from a year ago. Spring spinach acreage is up 17 percent, but the total winter and spring acreage is down. Decreases range from 23 percent for lima beans to 8 percent for winter spinach. The contracted tonnage of cabbage for kraut is expected to increase 8 percent from last year. Contracted area of lima and snap beans, sweet corn, peas and spinach for freezing is expected to be 16 percent below 1979 and the area for canning is anticipated to be down 11 percent.

GREEN LIMA BEANS: The 1980 contracted area planted for green lima beans is estimated at 51.6 thousand acres (20.9 thousand hectares), 23 percent below the area contracted in 1979. The area for freezing is expected to be down 30 percent and the canning acreage is expected to be down 14 percent. In California, planting continues active, but is somewhat behind schedule. Early plantings on the south coast look good. Planting is complete in Washington but milder weather is needed to stimulate growth. In Wisconsin, soil moisture has been adequate and the crop is making good growth.

SNAP BEANS: The preliminary contracted planted acreage of snap beans, estimated at 252 thousand acres (102 thousand hectares), for 1980 is 10 percent smaller than the area contracted a year ago. The area for freezing is anticipated to be 12 percent below a year ago, with a 9 percent drop in the acreage for canning. Crop prospects are good in Wisconsin. California's snap bean crop is progressing normally. In Washington, planting was delayed by rainfall in the western portions and by ash fallout from Mount St. Helens in the eastern area.

BEETS FOR CANNING: Contracted plantings of processing beets are estimated at 15.1 thousand acres (6100 hectares), down 22 percent from 1979. Early planted beets in Wisconsin are making good progress. Recent rains and warmer temperatures will hasten crop development.

SWEET CORN: The contracted planted area of sweet corn for processing is estimated at 406 thousand acres (164 thousand hectares), a decrease of 10 percent from the area contracted in 1979. Acreage of sweet corn planted for freezing is expected to be down 7 percent and the area for canning is expected to be down 11 percent. Minnesota's crop is progressing slower than normal due to excessive soil moisture. Wisconsin's sweet corn is progressing normally.

CUCUMBERS FOR PICKLES: The 1980 contracted area of cucumbers for pickles is estimated at 99.3 thousand acres (40.2 thousand hectares), 16 percent below the area contracted a year ago. The North Carolina crop is in fair to good condition with harvest underway. Wet weather in Wisconsin has hindered crop development. Cool temperatures in Washington have slowed crop development. California's crop is progressing normally.

GREEN PEAS: The preliminary planted acreage of green peas contracted for 1980 at 348 thousand acres (141 thousand hectares) is 16 percent below the contracted area for 1979. A decrease of 22 percent is expected in the area contracted for freezing and a 13 percent drop is expected in the canning area. Crop development and progress in Minnesota were hampered by dry conditions early in the season and rain and hail damage later. Crop prospects are good for Wisconsin's green peas. Cool, cloudy conditions in Washington have slowed the development of early plantings. California's green pea harvest was completed in mid-May.

TOMATOES: The contracted area of tomatoes for processing is estimated at 261 thousand acres (106 thousand hectares), a decrease of 17 percent from a year ago. In California, there was considerably more rain than normal during planting in south coastal counties and the northern San Joaquin and Sacramento Valleys. Cool weather delayed growth and development in most areas. Harvest started in the desert about June 10 and is expected to begin about mid-July in the southern San Joaquin Valley. Sacramento Valley harvest is expected to start in late July, followed by the central coast.

Tomato tonnage contracted for 1980 is estimated at 6.30 million tons (5.71 million metric tons), 13 percent below 1979. Contracted tonnage in California is 15 percent below the 1979 total production.

CABBAGE FOR KRAUT: Contracted tonnage of cabbage for kraut, estimated at 226 thousand tons (205 thousand metric tons), is up 8 percent from 1979. Planting in Wisconsin was delayed by wet weather.

SPRING SPINACH: The 1980 planted area of spring spinach is estimated at 5860 acres (2370 hectares), 17 percent above the acreage planted for 1979 spring crop. The area for freezing is expected to decrease 33 percent while the area for canning is expected to increase 47 percent. Total production for the spring crop is estimated at 31.3 thousand tons (28.4 thousand metric tons), up 84 percent from the spring crop a year ago.
