
SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

JULY 1967

Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during July 1967 was 397 thousand head, down 10 percent from July 1966, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 175 thousand head moved through public stockyards. This was a decrease of 5 percent from July 1966. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was 222 thousand head, 14 percent less than July 1966. Direct movement during July accounted for 56 percent of the total movement, compared with 58 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during the first 7 months of 1967 amounted to 2.8 million head, 9 percent below the same period in 1966.

July shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 76 thousand head--down 27 percent from a year earlier. The 26 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 10 percent less than a year earlier, and the 50 thousand head received direct was about one-third less than July 1966. During the period January-July 1967, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 573 thousand head, down 33 percent from the 859 thousand head shipped during the same months of 1966.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during July 1967 totaled 405 thousand head, about the same as were shipped during July 1966.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during July 1967 amounted to 43 thousand head--down 25 percent from the 57 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
