

SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP
DECEMBER 1963

Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during December 1963 was 578 thousand head, up 5 percent from December last year, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 188 thousand moved through public stockyards--13 percent less than in December 1962. However, the number of cattle and calves received direct in December 1963 was 391 thousand head, 16 percent more than a year earlier. The direct movement in December was 68 percent of the total, compared with 61 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during July-December 1963 totaled 4.5 million head, 10 percent less than the total for the same months in 1962.

December shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 122 thousand head--down 13 percent from a year earlier. The 40 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 21 percent below December 1962, and the 82 thousand head received direct was 8 percent less than a year earlier. During July-December 1963, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 1.6 million head, down 10 percent from the total for these months last year.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during December 1963 totaled 430 thousand head, 2 percent less than the 438 thousand head shipped in December 1962.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards in December 1963 were nearly 118 thousand head--down 4 percent from the 122 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
