

SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

JULY 1966

Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during July 1966 was 443 thousand, up 31 percent from July 1965, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 185 thousand head moved through public stockyards. This was an increase of 8 percent from July 1965. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was 258 thousand head, 54 percent more than July 1965. Direct movement during July accounted for 58 percent of the total movement, compared with 49 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during January-July 1966 amounted to 3.1 million head, 29 percent above the same period in 1965.

July shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 104 thousand head--down 8 percent from a year earlier. The 29 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 30 percent less than in July 1965, but the 75 thousand received direct was 5 percent more than a year earlier. During January-July 1966, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 859 thousand head, down 3 percent from the 884 thousand during the same months of 1965.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during July 1966 totaled 405 thousand, 7 percent less than the 438 thousand head shipped during July 1965.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during July 1966 amount to 57 thousand--down 6 percent from the 61 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
