#### Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8
North Central States during October 1967 was 1,468 thousand, up 3 percent
from October 1966, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle
and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 393 thousand head moved
through public stockyards. This was an increase of 12 percent from a year
earlier. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was
1,075 thousand head, about the same as October 1966. Direct movement during
October accounted for 73 percent of the total movement, compared with 75 percent
a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during July-October 1967
amounted to 3.4 million head, 3 percent above the same months in 1966.

October shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States totaled 300 thousand head--down II percent from a year earlier. The 80 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 33 percent more than in October 1966 but the 220 thousand received direct was 20 percent less than a year earlier. During July-October 1967, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 713 thousand, down 28 percent from the 996 thousand during the same months of 1966.

#### Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stock-yards during October 1967 totaled 905 thousand an increase of 3 percent from the 878 thousand head shipped during October 1966.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during October 1967 amount to 181 thousand--up 6 percent from the 171 thousand head inspected a year earlier.

ERRATA: The following changes should be made in the August and September 1967 reports for shipments of sheep and lambs.

August 1967: Shipments into South Dakota from public stockyards, 8,713 and direct, 6,550. Total 8 States from public stockyards, 47,193 and directs, 65,764.

September 1967: Direct receipts in Nebraska, 33,027. Total for public stockyards and direct, 40,254 and the July-Sept. total, 71,434. Total 8 States directs, 151,868. Total public stockyards and direct, 223,324 and the July-Sept. total, 412,211.
