

SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

JUNE 1967

Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during June 1967 was 326 thousand, down 12 percent from June 1966, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 186 thousand head moved through public stockyards. This was an increase of 12 percent from June 1966. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was 140 thousand head, 32 percent loss than June 1966. Direct movement during June accounted for 43 percent of the total movement, compared with 55 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during the first half of 1967 amounted to 2.4 million head, 8 percent below the same period in 1966.

June shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 96 thousand head--down 11 percent from a year earlier. The 32 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 14 percent less than in June 1966, and the 65 thousand received direct was 10 percent less than a year earlier. During the first half of 1966, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 497 thousand head, down 34 percent from the 755 thousand during the same months of 1966.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during June 1967 totaled 394 thousand, one percent more than the 389 thousand head shipped during June 1966.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during June 1967 amounted to 36 thousand--down 19 percent from the 44 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
