
SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

AUGUST 1966

Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during August 1966 was 576 thousand, up 8 percent from August 1965, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 207 thousand head moved through public stockyards. This was a decrease of 14 percent from August 1965. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was 368 thousand head, 26 percent more than August 1965. Direct movement during August accounted for 64 percent of the total movement, compared with 55 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during July and August 1966 amounted to 1.0 million head, 17 percent above the same months in 1965.

August shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 230 thousand head--up 21 percent from a year earlier. The 68 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 59 percent more than in August 1965 and the 162 thousand received direct was 9 percent more than a year earlier. During July and August 1966, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 334 thousand head, up 10 percent from the 304 thousand during the same months of 1965.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during August 1966 totaled 509 thousand, 3 percent less than the 527 thousand head shipped during August 1965.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during August 1966 amount to 135 thousand--up 34 percent from the 101 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
