

# **U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports**

**Fiscal Year (FY) 2025**

**June 2025**

The June WASDE report shows FY 2025 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 172,294 metric tons raw value (MTRV), unchanged from last month. See Table 3 for details.

FY 2026 WTO raw sugar TRQ shortfall is projected at 85,329 MTRV. No information is available about specific countries.

The fifth tranche of the FY 2025 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 45,000 MTRV on July 14, 2025. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
