

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2025

August 2025

The August WASDE report shows FY 2025 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 203,000 metric tons raw value (MTRV), up 30,300 MTRV from last month. See Table 3 for details.

FY 2026 WTO raw sugar TRQ shortfall is projected at 85,329 MTRV. No information is available about specific countries.
