FIELD CROPS

Production, Farm Use, Sales, and Value, by States, 1973-1974

This report is one of a series dealing with farm disposition of major farm products, and presents data for 1973 and 1974 specified commodities. It shows estimated production, sales (sold or to be sold), use (used or to be used for designated purposes on farms where grown), price, and value. The farm use, sales and value data shown in this report are for the marketing season or crop year. Production shown for each commodity is that published in the 1974 Annual Crop Production Summary. All production, price and value estimates for the 1974 crop are preliminary.

Estimates of farm use and sales relate to the disposition of a given year's production within the marketing season shown regardless of time of actual disposition. Quantities going into Government resale programs at the end of a current marketing year are included in sales. Therefore, resale grains stored on farms are included in the disposition during the marketing season for the year of production.

Estimates of quantities fed to livestock and poultry represent the portion of production fed on farms where produced. These estimates do not represent total quantities used for livestock and poultry feed. Some of the amounts shown as "sold" are used for feed and seed on other farms.

Total seed requirements are shown for certain crops, and a further breakdown made to show the amount of homegrown seed. The difference between total seed and homegrown seed would thus represent purchased seed, which is included in the total quantity sold.

Sales of some commodities are estimated directly from an analysis of survey data in which farmers report production and sales. For others, special disposition surveys are made in which farmers report their production of each commodity as well as the quantities used on their farms for each purpose. When possible, sales have been checked by enumeration, such as reports of processors, or by records of handlings and shipments by rail, truck, and boat. The entire production is considered sold for commodities with virtually no farm use.

State season average prices for most crops published in this report are computed by weighting mid-month prices by the estimated percent sold each month. For 1974 crops, midmonth prices are weighted by estimated sales through March 1975 with an allowance for marketings during the remainder of the marketing season. Midmonth prices are not available for broomcorn, hops, and popcorn. For these crops, special survey data are used as the basis for season average prices. The State and United States season average prices for barley, dry beans, corn, flaxseed, oats, rice, rye, sorghum grain, soybeans, and wheat include an allowance for unredeemed loans and purchases by the Government valued at the average loan and purchase rate, by States. The United States season average price shown for each crop is computed by dividing the U. S. value of sales by quantity sold. A United States season average price weighted by production can be derived by dividing the U. S. value of production by quantity produced.

The season average prices for quantities sold are also used to evaluate total quantities produced, and quantities used on farms. Value of sales is computed by applying the unit price to quantity sold during the marketing year. In like manner, value of production is computed by applying the season average price to the quantity produced. The value estimates shown should not be confused with cash receipts which relate to the calendar year irrespective of the year of production.

Season average prices and value of production including set-aside payments are also shown for corn, wheat, barley and sorghum grain. Set-aside payments include all government program payments which are assignable to a particular crop. The United States season average price plus set-aside payments is computed by dividing the U. S. value of production plus set-aside payments by production.

The U. S. monthly farm sales as a percent of the marketing year sales for selected crops are shown on page 28. The marketing season for each crop is shown on page 29.

Maple sirup production, farm use, sales and value for 1973 and 1974 crop have been excluded from this report. This information will be published in an Annual Maple Sirup Report to be released on May 20.

CORN: August 1 to July 31 for Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas; September 1 to August 31 for Missouri, Kansas, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, Arkansas, New Mexico, Arizona, and California; October 1 to September 30 for all other States.
