Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 5/16/2025

Compared to last week hay market mostly steady with 2nd cuttings are underway. According to National Agricultural statistics Services as of May 11, 2025. Alfalfa hay harvest continued to take place on approximately 60 percent of the crop's acreage throughout the State. Arizona's alfalfa crop was rated in mostly good to excellent condition, with only 2 percent of the crop rated fair. Over the past week, measurable precipitation was experienced across much of the State, however, eastern Maricopa, central Navajo, and southeastern counties remained relatively dry. According to data from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), the La Posa Plain and southern areas of the Aquarius Mountains received the most precipitation, accumulating approximately 2.50 inches while other areas of the State received anywhere from trace amounts to 2.00 inches of total precipitation. Arizona's drought information statements remained in effect in response to enduring above average temperatures and below average precipitation.
