National FOB shell egg weighted average prices are steady to slightly higher. The undertone is steady. Retail demand is light to moderate while food service demand is light to instances moderate. Offerings are light to moderate. Supplies are moderate to at times light. Market activity is moderate. California weighted average delivered prices are lightly tested. The undertone is weak. Demand is light for the light offerings. Supplies are moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. The 6-Area Total shell egg inventory increased 1.0% compared to a week ago.
