National FOB shell egg weighted average prices are steady to sharply lower. The undertone is weak. Retail demand is light to moderate with improvement noted where promotional activity is planned. Loose egg movement ranges light to instances fairly good, best movement into food service channels in destination locations. Offerings are about moderate. Supplies are mixed, varying by region. Market activity is moderate. California weighted average delivered prices are lower for Large. The undertone is lower. Demand is in a range of light to occasionally fairly good, mostly light to seasonally moderate. Offerings are generally moderate. Supplies are moderate to fully adequate. Market activity is slow to moderate.
