National FOB shell egg weighted average prices are about steady to higher for caged eggs. The undertone remains generally steady. Retail and loose egg movement is light to moderate for the light to moderate offerings. Supplies are moderate. Market activity is moderate to slow. California weighted average delivered prices are lightly tested. The undertone is weak. Retail and food service demand is light to instances moderate. Offerings are light to moderate. Supplies are moderate and reported as adequate for current needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. The 6-Area Total shell egg inventory declined 2.4% when compared to a week ago.
