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ICE CREAM PRODUCTION

Ice cream production in the United States in June is estimated at 77,110,000 gallons: fractionally more than the enumerated total in June 1965 and 6 percent larger than the 1960-64 average for the month, the Crop Reporting Board reports. The seasonal increase from May to June was 17 percent, compared with 15 percent at this time last year, and 11 percent on the average in the 1960-64 period. Temperatures during June averaged below normal in a major portion of the country, but were normal or above in two important areas: (1) all north of a line from Delaware to the southeast corner of South Dakota, and including a considerable section of the northern and middle Great Plains; (2) California, Nevada, Utah, and sections of adjoining states.

Compared with June 1965, changes in ice cream manufacture by regions were mixed. Production was 1 percent less in both the North Atlantic and the East Central Regions, and 4 percent smaller in the Mountain. Output was about the same in the South Atlantic States. Increases were 3 percent in the West North Central Region, 5 percent in the South Central, and 2 percent in the Pacific. In the leading-producing states, production was up 4 percent in California and 5 percent in Pennsylvania, but was down 11 percent in New York.

Compared with the 1960-64 average for the month, the Mountain States showed unchanged production, while all other regions had increases. Production was 4 percent more in both the North Atlantic and the South Atlantic Regions. Output was up 5 percent in the East North Central States and 9 percent in the West North Central. Other increases were 10 percent in the South Central Region and 11 percent in the Pacific. Production was up 2 percent in Pennsylvania and 13 percent in California, but was down 6 percent in New York.

Revised ice cream estimates, by states, for January-May 1966 are shown on page 5. Enumerated data for 1965, by states and months, will be available about July 29 in annual release "Production of Manufactured Dairy Products" which may be secured upon request to this office. All U.S. totals include production in Alaska and Hawaii.

ICE MILK PRODUCTION

Ice milk production in the United States during June, estimated at 29,190,000 gallons, is 9 percent larger than the enumerated total in June 1965 and 30 percent greater than the 1960-64 average for the month. The January-June output was up 6 percent from the corresponding period in 1965 and 34 percent from the 5-year average.

The seasonal gain from May to June was 19 percent this year, compared with 13 percent last year and 16 percent in the 1960-64 period. Seasonal advances occurred in all regions of the country. June output was larger than a year earlier in all regions except the South Central. The sharpest increases occurred in the North Atlantic and the two North Central regions.

SHERBET PRODUCTION

Sherbet manufacture in the United States was 5,775,000 gallons in June - 6 percent more than in June 1965 and 9 percent larger than the 1960-64 June average. Cumulative production by mid-year was 5 percent more than in the first half of 1965 and 13 percent larger than the 5-year average for the period.

Compared with May, output advanced 18 percent. This compares with seasonal gains of 14 percent in 1965 and 17 percent on the average in the 1960-64 period. All regions showed seasonal advances. Compared with June 1965, sharp increases in the North Atlantic Region, the East North Central, and the Pacific more than offset decreases in the remaining regions.

"MELLORINE-TYPE" FROZEN DESSERTS PRODUCTION

Production of Mellorine and other frozen desserts made with fats and oils other than milkfat in the United States during June was estimated at 5,850,000 gallons. This is up 6 percent from the revised total in June 1965 and 10 percent from the 1960-64 average for the month. Output in the first half of 1966 was about the same as in the half-year period in 1965, but 8 percent larger than the 5-year average.

The seasonal advance from May to June was 20 percent this year, compared with 11 percent a year earlier and an average of 10 percent in the 1960-64 period. All producing states showed gains except South Carolina and Montana. Compared with June 1965, production decreased in Arkansas, Oklahoma, Montana, Arizona, and Oregon. Increases occurred in all other producing states.

WATER ICE PRODUCTION

U.S. production of water ices in June of 6,395,000 gallons, is 6 percent more than in June 1965 and 9 percent larger than the 1960-64 average for the month. Total output through June this year was 2 percent less than in the first 6 months of 1965, but 6 percent more than the preceding 5-year average.

Production jumped 39 percent between May and June, in contrast to only 8 percent at this time a year earlier and 19 percent in the 1960-64 period. Sharp seasonal gains were observed in all regions of the country. Compared with June 1965, output increased in all regions except the East North Central, where it was unchanged.
