## FARM EMPLOYMENT, MARCH 1, 1936

Employment in agriculture increased somewhat less than the usual seasonal amount during February as unfavorable weather retarded late winter farm activities in the northern part of the country. On farms of crop reporters employment of family workers showed about an average seasonal rise, but additions to the hired labor group were considerably less than usual.

Crop correspondents reported an average of 201 family workers per 100 farms on March 1 as compared with 198 a month earlier and 215 persons on March 1, 1935. Crop reporter farms employed 74 persons per 100 farms on the first of this month as compared with 71 on February 1. Although March 1 employment of hired labor did not show as large an increase over February 1 employment as the average increase for other recent years, 5 more hired workers were reported per 100 farms of crop reporters than on March 1, 1935.
